SECURITY CAMERAS IN TAXICABS

Effective immediately, the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection (BACP) has the following new policy in regards to the use of security camera images:

1. BACP and the Chicago Police Department will continue to have the authority to request access to a taxicab and its camera equipment to download recorded images of the interior or exterior of the taxicab.
2. A taxicab medallion license holder and licensed taxicab medallion license manager may have direct access to download recorded images of the interior or exterior of the taxicab they own or manage. Taxicab medallion license holders and licensed taxicab medallion license managers must comply with Federal, State, and City laws, specifically laws regarding the use of recorded images and privacy.
