The Department of Water Management is requesting an Operational Emergency in the amount of \$40,000 for the maintenance of the Chlorine Emergency Evacuation Paging System located at the South Water and Jardine Purification Plants. The systems have experienced equipment problems including computer processing unit malfunctions along with amplifier board failures. The cause of these problems has not been determined and the systems are currently not in operation. Water Management is presently in consultation with the supplier of the systems, Interstate Electronics, on the development of a maintenance contract. Until such time as a contract is finalized, an emergency contract must be established with Interstate Electronics to provide immediate emergency service.

Your prompt consideration of this matter is greatly appreciated.
