Dear Ms. Lumpkin:

The Department of Transportation (CDOT), Division of In-House Construction (Streets) requires an emergency purchase of concrete. These goods/services are necessary for the completion of various CDOT projects. Speedy Ready Mix, the vendor for concrete for the south area has been found in default. Speedy Ready Mix's failure to deliver concrete has negatively impacted the production output of the Department of Transportation and has forced the department to incur significant additional expenses as a result. Accordingly, CDOT is requesting an emergency purchase order not to exceed \$100,000.

There have been numerous occasions where CDOT has been forced to use Wille Brothers Company to provide concrete because this company meets CDOT specifications, delivery requirements, and can immediately service the CDOT crews. Currently no contract exists with this vendor to purchase this item. This request will be used until a new contract will be awarded.
