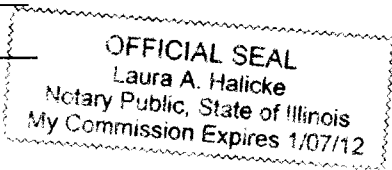

The major features include concrete repair, adding reinforcing steel to the underside of the deck, and the pouring of new concrete.
