Notification for receipt of gift from Collier IT

This letter is to notify that the Department of Innovation and Technology is receiving a gift of services and materials for educational training from Collier IT. Collier IT is willing to provide educational training services with a market value of \$103,150 to the City of Chicago for training on the city's recently acquired database and business intelligence platform. Collier is also willing to fund the travel for the instructor to provide the course in Chicago, which is estimated at \$6,600.
