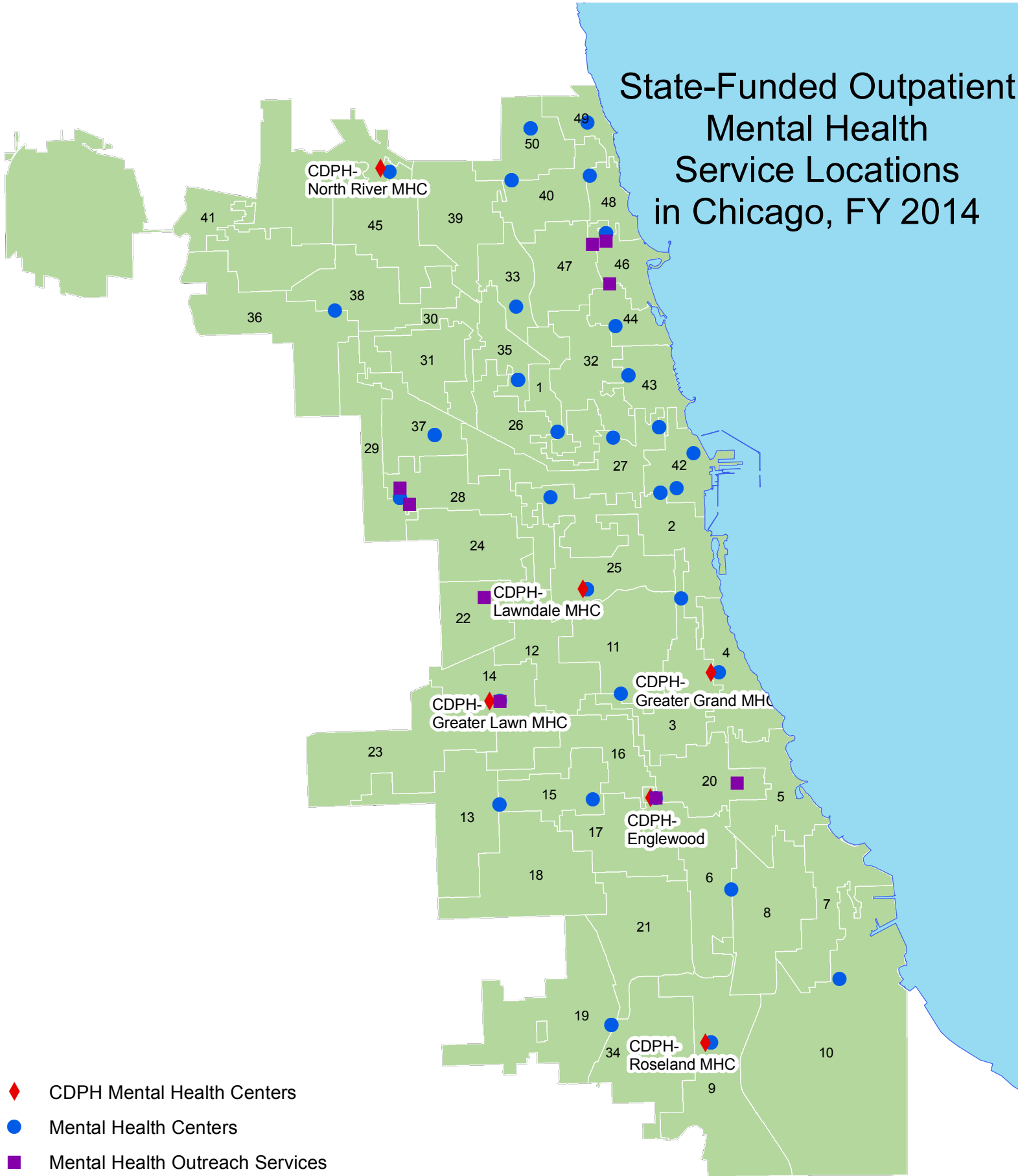

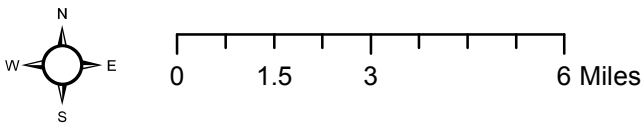

FROM A 75-CENT CIGARETTE TAX INCREASE IN CHICAGO, ILLINOIS**

Current cigarette tax in Chicago, IL: 68 cents per pack

- Small tax increase amounts do not produce significant public health benefits or cost savings because the cigarette companies can easily offset the beneficial impact of such small increases with temporary price cuts, coupons, and other promotional discounting. Splitting a tax rate increase into separate, smaller increases in successive years will similarly diminish or eliminate the public health benefits and related cost savings (as well as reduce the amount of new revenues).
- Implementing tax rates on other tobacco products (OTPs) to parallel the increased cigarette tax rate will bring the city more revenues, public health benefits, and cost savings (and promote tax equity). With unequal rates, the city would lose revenue each time a cigarette smoker switched to cigars, roll-your-own tobacco, or smokeless tobacco products. To parallel the new \$1.43 per pack cigarette tax, the OTP tax rate should be at least 45% of wholesale price with minimum tax rates for each major OTP category linked to the cigarette tax rate on a per-package or per-dose basis.

Explanations & Notes

In addition to the city's cigarette tax, cigarette packs sold in Chicago are also subject to Cook County's \$3.00 per pack cigarette tax and the state's \$1.98 per pack cigarette tax, as well as the federal cigarette tax rate of \$1.01 per pack.

City-level data are from the U.S. Census Bureau, Illinois Department of Public Health, U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System, Youth Risk Behavior Survey), the City of Chicago Office of Budget & Management, and the Chicago Department of Public Health. These projections are calculated based on a model to determine state-level benefits from a cigarette tax increase.

Projections are based on research findings that each 10% cigarette price increase reduces youth smoking by 6.5%, adult rates by 2%, and total consumption by about 4% (adjusted down to account for tax evasion effects). Revenues still increase because the higher tax rate per pack will bring in more new revenue than is lost from the tax-related drop in total pack sales.

The projections incorporate the effect of both ongoing background smoking declines and the continued impact of the \$1 per pack cigarette tax increase in Illinois (effective June 24, 2012) and the \$1 per pack cigarette tax increase in Cook County, IL (effective March 1, 2013), as well as the 61.66-cent federal cigarette tax increase (effective April 1, 2009) on prices, smoking levels, and pack sales.

Kids stopped from smoking and dying are from all kids alive today. Long-term cost savings accrue over the lifetimes of persons who stop smoking or never start because of the tax rate increase. All cost savings in 2013 dollars.

Ongoing reductions in city smoking rates will, over time, gradually erode cigarette tax revenues (in the absence of any new rate increases). But those declines are more predictable and less volatile than many other revenue sources. In addition, the smoking declines that reduce tobacco tax revenues will simultaneously produce much larger reductions in government and private sector smoking-caused costs. During our recent hearing to discuss the 2014 proposed budget, Alderman Tunney requested the number of "Risk 1" restaurants in Chicago.

Retail food establishments are broken down into different categories based on the relative risk of causing foodborne illness and are classified as "Category I", "Category II", and "Category III." Category I, or "Risk 1", restaurants are those that pose the greatest risk not because they are necessarily in a delinquent state but because there is a greater potential for foodborne illness. These classifications are verified annually. Currently, there are 17,327 retail food establishments in the city. 8,083 have been identified as Category 1, or "Risk 1". The remaining 9,244 food establishments are either Category 2 (3,773) or Category 3 (5,471).

Chicago Department of Public Health Mental Health Services 2013 Report

In 2012, as the Chicago Department of Public Health (CDPH) looked to improve the quality of its care, it became clear that important health reforms had to be made to the department's mental health services in order to successfully serve the people of Chicago in tough economic times. To accomplish this, CDPH leadership sat down with community mental health providers and advocacy groups to develop a plan that would leverage other service providers while making needed improvements to CDPH's own system.

The resulting reforms improved access to care, increased capacity of the city's overall mental health system, and expanded partnerships to serve more residents with mental illness, particularly the uninsured. This report further describes these activities and serves as an update to CDPH's *Mental Health Service 2012 Report*.

Improved Access to Care

CDPH has increased access to mental health services for uninsured and underinsured residents in Chicago through its mental health clinics.

- As of August 2013, CDPH's mental health clinics had 2,440 active clients—an increase of 71 active clients over the 2,369 that were being served immediately after the transition in April 2012.
- CDPH continues to maintain capacity to serve 4,000 residents annually and continues to accept new clients. In fact, CDPH's mental health clinics added nearly 600 new patients in the first three quarters of 2013, and over 1,300 new patients since the transition.
- The number of mental health-related hospitalizations for clients served at City clinics has remained stable since the transition. As of October, 135 hospitalizations have occurred this year, compared to 180 incidents in 2012, 267 in 2011, and 293 in 2010. As another comparison, the rate of hospitalizations has remained stable, with a rate of 4.6% in 2010 and 4.8% thus far for 2013.

Increased Capacity

Through collaborations with community partners and targeted investments in the city's mental health infrastructure, CDPH has increased the capacity of the city's mental health system.

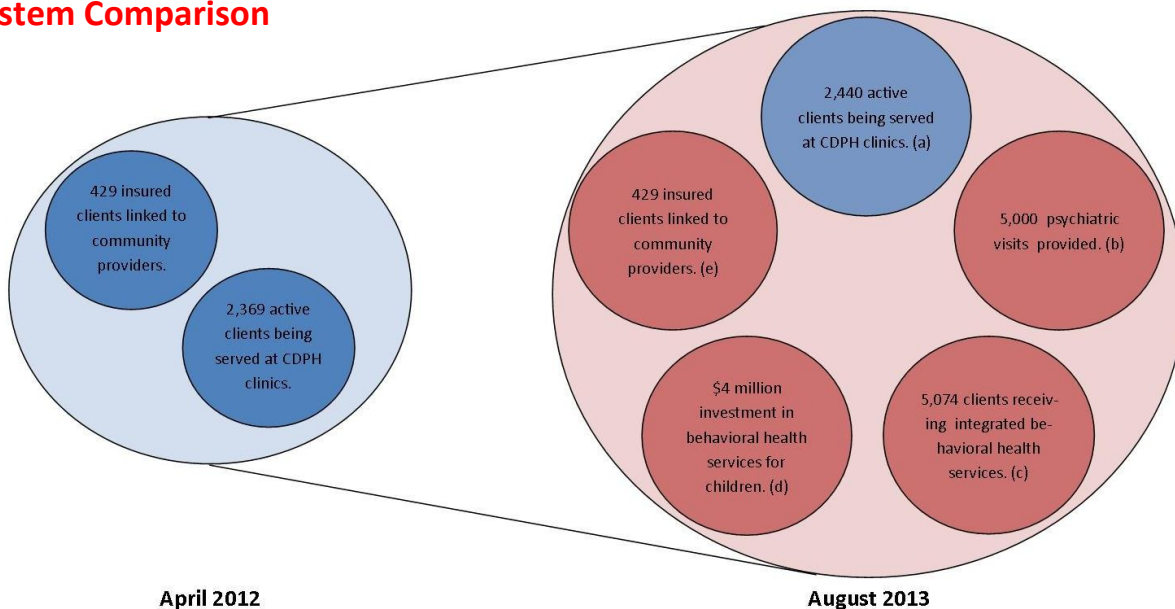
- CDPH expanded psychiatric services by reinvesting \$500,000 from the mental health reform into eight community partners; resulting in more than 5,000 psychiatric visits being completed in the first three quarters of 2013.
- CDPH also received a three-year grant from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) which provides \$1 million per year to community partners to provide integrated behavioral health, substance abuse, and HIV services to over 5,000 residents.

- CDPH partnered with Human Resources Development Institute (HRDI) and Thresholds to return mental health services to clinics that were closed during the transition. HRDI is currently providing services at the City's Auburn-Gresham location and Thresholds will soon re-open the Woodlawn site now that the lease has been approved by City Council.
- CDPH collaborated with the Illinois Children's Healthcare Foundation, which recently awarded a \$4 million grant, to provide integrated behavioral health services, including mental health services, to children in need on Chicago's south and west sides.

Expanded Partnerships

For more than two years, CDPH has convened a multidisciplinary task force to better address the needs of persons with serious mental illness who are homeless and/or involved with the criminal justice system. This task force includes the Cook County Sheriff's Office, Chicago Police Department, Chicago Department of Family and Support Services, community providers, advocacy groups, consumers, and CDPH. Many members of the task force collaborated to create Together4Health, a new care coordination entity to identify highly vulnerable Chicagoans and link them to clinical care, as well as housing, substance abuse treatment, and access to food. Together4Health is funded by the State of Illinois and will begin enrolling clients this December.

System Comparison

- Through CDPH's reinvestment of \$500,000 in its community partners in 2012, 5,000 additional psychiatric visits have been provided to uninsured and underinsured clients.
- Community-based organizations provided over 5,000 clients with integrated behavioral health and substance abuse services as a result of a new \$3 million, 3-year grant from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA).
- The City worked closely with Illinois Children's Healthcare Foundation to secure a \$4 million grant to provide integrated behavioral health services, including mental health services, to Chicago's children.
- CDPH maintained partnerships with more than 40 community mental health providers to successfully transition 429 insured residents' care; creating more availability for uninsured and underinsured to access services at CDPH clinics.

During the Office of Budget and Management's recent hearing to discuss the 2014 proposed budget, Alderman Sposato asked why the City was investing additional resources in eye exams for Chicago Public Schools' students, but not hearing.

CPS currently administers hearing screenings that help identify children with potential hearing problems. So far in 2013, CPS has provided hearing screenings to 176,910 students. From these screenings, 1,386 students were referred to specialists for specific ear, nose and throat and audiology examinations.

During the Office of Budget and Management's recent hearing to discuss the 2014 proposed budget, Alderman Laurino requested more information on the Federally Qualified Health Centers' (FQHCs) performance and locations.

With input from residents, health care providers and community leaders, the Chicago Department of Public Health (CDPH) developed a comprehensive improvement plan to expand primary care services by transitioning seven City clinic facilities into community-based Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs).

In their first year of operation, the FQHCs not only sustained care in these seven communities, but expanded access. With 53,000 patient visits and 13,000 uninsured patients served during their first year, our FQHC partners are increasing access and service to all Chicagoans. Expansion has continued to accelerate in 2013. Between January and June, there have been 32% more patient encounters than the same period in 2012. These trends project continued growth in the months to come.

One particular success story is Erie Family Health Center's Division Street Clinic, which has seen a continuous increase in patient encounters. Following a series of service improvements and facility renovations in 2012, patient encounters at Erie surpassed those of the earlier City clinic. Their growth notably accelerated in the first half of 2013, with patient encounters being 48%

greater than the volume over the same period in 2012. Other FQHC's have seen considerable increases in patient visits over the same period.

The improvement plan included working with residents and community groups to find new, innovative ways to improve the overall patient experience. These new initiatives include:

- 1) **More convenient hours:** Taking time off of work for medical appointments can be challenging, particularly for patients requiring frequent visits. Patients at the South Lawndale and West Town clinics can now access care when it is convenient to them thanks to extended evening and Saturday hours offered by our FQHC partners there.
- 2) **Increased community leadership:** Each FQHC must have a governing board comprised of community members and clinic patients. This policy helps ensure each center is serving with the community's best interests at heart.
- 3) **Direct connection to CountyCare:** Uninsured Chicagoans can access health insurance through CountyCare, a form of Medicaid expansion. All seven FQHC partners are part of the CountyCare network, assisting with outreach and enrollment, and can provide care for enrollees, giving more opportunities for residents to access needed services.
- 4) **New academic partnerships:** A number of FQHCs are connected with local academic centers including Mile Square Health Center, an affiliate of the University of Illinois, and Erie Family Health Center, an affiliate of Northwestern University. As such, patients at these sites can be referred quickly and easily to nationally recognized hospitals.
- 5) **Renovated facilities:** By leveraging public and private funds, all facilities have been upgraded. Ranging from new flooring to complete renovations, patients have welcomed these changes and the improved comfort they provide

As designed, the improvement plan was expected to increase services to Chicagoans while also saving Chicago taxpayers \$10 million in the first year. In reality, the savings totaled \$12 million, a 20% increase over original estimates. The reforms brought needed improvements to quality and access to care, all while saving an impressive \$12 million in taxpayer money that can be used to reinvest in other initiatives.
