Did you know you could save up to \$30 on your home internet service? Stop in to one of the above CPL locations to learn more and get one-on-one assistance with the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP).

The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is a federal program that makes broadband internet more affordable for eligible households.

You are eligible if you receive government assistance through certain State and Federal programs. You may also qualify based on your income.

You may need the following documentation to apply:

- Proof of identity (valid government ID, passport, resident card or green card)
- Address (valid government ID, utility bill, mortgage statement or lease)
- Qualifying program participation (benefit award letter, statement, or school documentation)
- Household income (bank statement, check stub, or Social Security benefits statement)
