On October 18, 1990, the Board of Ethics received your request for an advisory opinion concerning a possible undisclosed financial interest of Employee A [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] your Department. We appreciate your bringing this matter to our attention and your willingness to follow the ethical standards embodied in the Ordinance.

You informed us that the Department, while making a routine review of the documents filed for Minority Business Certification for Company X, found that Employee A's spouse [REDACTED] is the president of the company. The Department also found that Employee A is listed on the company's 1987 income tax return under Schedule E, Compensation of Officers. You felt that Employee A's involvement in Company X might be an undisclosed financial interest in City business, and asked the Board to address the matter.

The staff contacted Employee A to obtain information concerning her connection with Company X. During that conversation Employee A stated that she had resigned her position with the City. On [REDACTED], the staff confirmed this information with a supervisor [REDACTED] in your department.

Because Employee A is no longer employed with the



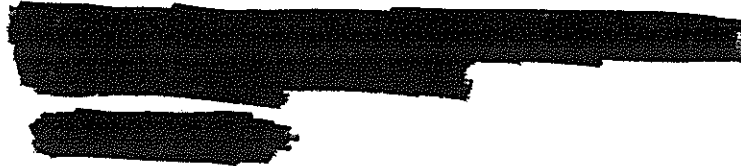
