REPORT OF COMMUNITY INPUT RECEIVED
AT THE PUBLIC MEETING ON OCTOBER 19, 2023
Date of Report: November 16, 2023

Three members of the public spoke during the public comments portion of the meeting. See the transcript of the meeting, posted on the Board's website, for the complete remarks of each speaker.

The Chicago Police Department responded to the comments of Kyton Toney. Yolanda Talley, Chief of CPD's Bureau of Internal Affairs, reached out to Mr. Toney. Chief Talley reported that she spoke with Mr. Toney by phone for about 20 minutes on November 8. She noted that one of the matters they discussed was an open COPA investigation where he is the complainant, and she said she informed him that she would notify COPA and let them know of his concerns. Chief Talley reported that Mr. Toney left the conversation satisfied and appreciative that she reached out to him.

The remarks made by the other speakers did not require a response in addition to that provided at the meeting.
