Dear Mr. Fuller:

The National Park Service has reviewed the historic property inventory for archeological sites completed in July 2018 by the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) as part of the subject undertaking in Jackson Park. Our office has also reviewed the subsequent IDOT submittal to further evaluate the sites under Criteria A, B and C for eligibility to the National Register of Historic Places (National Register), as requested in a letter from the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation to the Federal Highway Administration (ACHPCConnect: 012213).

We concur with the IDOT determination that none of the sites identified in Jackson Park within the area of potential effect are eligible for the National Register under Criteria A, B, C, or D.
