CLASS TITLE: LABORER

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE CLASS: Under immediate supervision, performs unskilled manual labor in connection with the painting and marking of City streets; and performs related duties as required.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES: Loads and unloads daily work materials from trucks; assists skilled tradesmen in the layout and painting of street markings; sets up barricades to block off streets being painted; sweeps and applies chalk lines to streets; operates various paint machines to apply, reapply or remove pavement markings; ensures that proper tools and equipment are on hand and in good working order.

DESIRABLE MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Training and Experience. Willingness and ability to perform the duties listed above; or an equivalent combination of training and experience.

Knowledge, Abilities and Skill. Knowledge of the tools and equipment used in the painting and marking of streets.

Ability to follow oral and written instructions. Ability to perform tasks requiring physical strength and endurance.

Working skill in the use of tools and equipment used in painting and marking streets.
