Narrative Providing Justification for Sole Source Administration of the WorkNet Chicago Employer Initiative Program for the Mayor's Office of Workforce Development

Procurement History:

The WorkNet Chicago Employer Initiative Program is a new procurement that provides employers with a financial incentive for hiring hard to place individuals such as ex-offenders, CHA residents and people with disabilities. The program evolved out of a Mayoral initiative to encourage employers to hire from these target groups. MOWD intends to use its existing Workforce Centers and the Safer Foundation (an existing delegate) that were selected under a previous competitive process to implement the program. The Workforce Centers are the largest delegate agencies in MOWD's network and have the unique capability of implementing the program for the entire system. The program is designed to reimburse employers up to \$2000 per person for hiring a person from a hard to serve population that completed a MOWD program. Individuals must be pre-screened by the delegate agency and employment must be verified in order for the business to receive payment. The majority of the funds involved are passed through to the employer. Because the program is designed to serve existing job seekers from MOWD's Workforce Investment Act (WIA) System, a competitive procurement was not attempted. The procurement is really just adding a feature to an existing scope as opposed to procuring a new program or service. By adding a new service to existing agencies MOWD is able to leverage existing WIA funds and services. It is important to note that all agencies in MOWD's network can have participants that benefit from this service. The Workforce Centers will provide this service for the network. The Safer Foundation is also recommended to be a delegate because of the large volume of ex-offenders (a target population for this initiative) that they place into employment.

Estimated Costs:

The <u>corporate-funded</u> total amount is \$2,000,000, to be awarded as follows: \$300,000 to five of the six Workforce Centers and \$200,000 to the Manufacturing Workforce Center (one contract is lower because it serves a lower number of individuals in the target population. The Safer Foundation, a larger WIA affiliate specializing in serving exoffenders, would receive \$300,000 toward this initiative.

The contract time period is April 1, 2007 until March 30, 2008.

The City of Chicago has invested existing funds and resources into the Workforce Centers. The WorkNet Chicago Employer Initiative Program allows these delegates to provide a financial incentive to employers to help our customers obtain and retain employment. By going through existing Workforce Centers, MOWD leverages funds and improves our existing services to businesses.

Because this is largely pass through funds to employers, MOWD will need to negotiate the administrative and programmatic costs for implementing the program with each delegate agency. MOWD will hold all delegates to a maximum of 20% costs in administrative and program costs.

Schedule Requirements:

The Mayor's Office and MOWD have developed a timeline to initiate the program by April 15, 2007.

Exclusive or Unique Capability:

MOWD currently has 6 Workforce Centers throughout the City of Chicago that serve as the main entrance points for job seekers and business. These existing centers are scope of services, delegate agencies provide services to both job seekers and businesses that essentially centers around helping individuals obtain employment and helping employers find quality workers. This new business service - providing a financial reimbursement to businesses for hiring hard to serve populations, can best and most efficiently be implemented through MOWD's existing Workforce Centers. Through this initiative businesses will be reimbursed up to \$2000 for each person hired that is from a hard to serve population. The delegate agency will certify people for the businesses, verify placements, track retention for up to 12 weeks, and pay out cash incentives to employers. The Workforce Centers were selected to implement this program because of the volume of customers they serve, their geographic access points for customers, and the financial and organizational capacity of the delegates operating the Workforce Centers. They are the most uniquely qualified to implement an incentive program for the entire system.

The Safer Foundation is also an existing WIA provider being chosen to implement this new service. Because ex-offenders are being targeted for this service and the Safer Foundation is the largest agency in the City of Chicago devoted to exclusively serving ex-offenders, they have a unique capability of issuing a financial incentive to employers who hire ex-offenders.

The new WorkNet Chicago Employer Initiative Program requires significant organizational and fiscal capacity unique to the Workforce Centers and the Safer Foundation.


