The Retirement Board of the Chicago Policemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund appeared on a list of City agencies that the Board of Ethics received from the Mayor's Office. The information which you presented to the Board in your letter dated October 31, 1987, however, indicates that the Retirement Board of the Chicago Policemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund is a state chartered agency.

We have reviewed the state charter which created the Retirement Board of the Chicago Policemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund, and have concluded that this agency is not a division of City government. Thus, the Board of Ethics does not have jurisdiction over this agency. We therefore concur with your opinion that as a member of such an agency you are not required to file a Statement of Financial Interest with the City.
