**ORDER**

This cause coming to be heard on the trial call, the parties represented by respective counsel, and this Commission having been advised by counsel for the Applicant that it would present no evidence and asking for leave to withdraw its appeal.

It is the Decision of the License Appeal Commission to allow the Applicant to withdraw its appeal. Based on the withdrawal of the appeal and the presentation of no evidence, the decision of the Local Liquor Control Commissioner to deny the issuance of the liquor license based on law enforcement concerns of the 18<sup>th</sup> District Police Commander and based on deleterious impact issues raised by the objection from the 42<sup>nd</sup> Ward Alderman is affirmed.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the said order or action of the Local Liquor Control Commissioner of the City of Chicago be and the same hereby is AFFIRMED.

Pursuant to Section 154 of the Illinois Liquor Control Act, a petition for rehearing may be filed with this Commission within TWENTY (20) days after service of this order. The date of the mailing of this order is deemed to be the date of service. If any party wishes to pursue an administrative review action in the Circuit Court, the petition for rehearing must be filed with this Commission within TWENTY (20) days after service of this order as such petition is a jurisdictional prerequisite to the administrative review.
