CICERO EDENS Across from Gompers Park (site 29, pp. 56-57), on the northeast side of the North Branch of the Chicago River, lies River's Edge at Sauganash, a residential development. A conservation easement from the developer to the Chicago Park District is in place that provides for the enhancement of natural habitat along the river. A tall fence and thick woods with a mixture of native and nonnative trees currently separate visitors from the water. At the top of the bank, on the accessible side of the fence, there is a wide swath of mowed grass that could be designed and planted with native flowers, grasses and shrubs.

To the west of the Conservation Area is the forest preserve district LaBagh Woods (site 7, p. 77).
