CHICAGO'S COVID GUIDELINES ARE THE LAW

REMINDER:

All public chauffeurs are required to wear masks/face coverings while transporting passengers in public passenger vehicles (taxicabs, transportation network or ride-hail vehicles, liveries, tour boats, charter-sightseeing vehicles, etc.).

Currently, recipients of COVID-19 vaccinations are not exempt from wearing face coverings as required. Click here for "[Guidance on the Use of Face Coverings](#)".
