The Use of Portable Hand Sinks for Temporary Cooking or Food Preparation Stations

The use of portable hand sinks for temporary food preparation areas or cooking stations is allowed subject to the following:

- 1) The temporary food preparation area(s) or cooking area(s) is within or on the property of and under the direct control and management of a City of Chicago licensed food establishment such as a restaurant, a food store, a mercantile or assembly establishment licensed to sell or serve food, or a cooking school.
- 2) The food establishment has a current license from the Department of Public Health and the use of the temporary food preparation station or cooking area has received Department of Health review and approval.
- 3) The licensed food establishment must have an employee who holds a current Food Service Manager Certificate on the premises during the use of the portable hand sink(s).
- 4) If the Sink is filled by a hose, the hose shall be a listed or certified NSF Food Grade Hose.
- 5) If there is a temporary electrical connection to a portable hand sink it shall conform to City of Chicago Electrical Code.
