# Chicago Police Department's Response to Community Input at the 16 December 2021 Police Board Meeting

- Bureau of Patrol (BOP) personnel contacted Speaker Crawford concerning 003<sup>rd</sup> District staffing. BOP personnel shared information with Speaker Crawford of the Department's recruiting efforts.
- Office of Community Policing personnel contacted Speaker Edwards concerning community engagement strategies and the hiring of community organizers. Additional community organizers are tentatively slated for hiring in the summer of 2022. Office of Community Policing personnel will work with Speaker Edwards to encourage her continued participation in community engagements.
- Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Section personnel contacted Speaker Patino concerning her FOIA request.
