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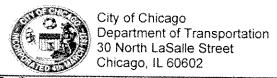

1. Please describe the major features of this project.

Reconstruct a reinforced concrete roadway/deck over the north portal opening of the LaSalle Street Trolley Tunnel at Kinzie Street.

2. Please explain why this project could not be bid using the city's traditional bid process and the need to use JOC Procurement system.

The north portal support system cannot adequately support the roadway or loads located above the structural supports. Then structural memebers are degraded to a point that warrants immediate action. The members need to be replaced in lieu of being repaired. They are exhibiting advanced degree of corrosion, including loss of section, deterioration, and/or spalling. In-House forces cannot perform this work because of the equipment and material required to remove and replace the concrete decking and structural supports are speciality items. There is no exisiting Term Agreement covering this item of work and it is not time and cost effective to perform this work through the traditinal bid process.

While inspecting the Tunnel system in early 2007, it was apparent the conditions in the LaSalle Street Trolley portion of the tunnel had deteriorated rapidly. The steel webbing off the structural members had fallen out completely. Once the steel webbing has fallen out or deliminated, the integrity of the support system is seriously compromised. Therefore, the structural members need to be replaced immediately. Upon noticing the severity of the situation, CDOT initiated the process for developing a set detailed drawings. As of 05/23/2007, the drawings are nearly complete and will be finalized shortly. Once the drawings are complete, CDOT would like to start construction as soon as possible. Therefore, we are requesting to use the JOC procurement system in lieu of traditional bidding.
