EXCLUSIVE OR UNIQUE CAPABILITY

The objective of this boat is to provide continuing search and rescue abilities as well as conducting homeland security missions in the toughest of sea and weather conditions. SAFE boats presently holds production contracts with the USCG and the USMC to build similar vessels. Their design features are unique and are exclusively patent protected under (9) U.S. Patents. The properties covered include the full buoyancy flotation collar and independent sealed hull floatation system. Should the hull be compromised this vessel would remain afloat, ensuring the safety of our officers. Additionally this collar system is rated to provide ballistic resistance for small arms fire including stopping a 45 cal. handgun round at 3 meters. The vessel is rated for a 15ft. surf state and features a self righting cabin feature. The hull system which is again unique and covered by patent includes "performance fins" which allows greater stability and turning under extreme conditions.

This unique hull system will also be rated to travel through broken ice with a thickness of 1ft at dimension of 20ft x 20ft. This exceeds by far current capabilities. Finally, standardization of platforms or the uniformity of working with a single maker, improves the safety to operators and crew. Lastly, these unique features coupled with outfitting the vessel with a lowerable stem, decontamination shower for divers, surveillance and night vision systems and a jet driven power system makes this a vessel which will help to ensure that safety of crew and provide the best level of service to the City.



SUBJECT: Expanded Sole-Source Justification – 45 Ft. Safe Boat(s)

The following basic synoptic is forwarded to expand on the exclusive patent information and verbal discussion with members of the City of Chicago Sole Source Board.

The need to purchase a modified "Archangel" 45 Ft. safe boat is grounded in the desire to provide the highest level of safety to Chicago Police Marine Officers while in the performance of their duties. Currently, much of the "fleet" of the Chicago Police Marine Unit is reaching its point of operational and economic obsolescence. Two Vessels, 31ft safe boats have been purchased at present. The desire is to maintain continuity in the boats used in daily duties. By doing so there is less risk of confusion of operating systems or performance under adverse conditions. The additional benefit and savings is incurred by not needing to train officers amongst a diversity of platforms as well as by limiting tooling and training costs for City mechanics in servicing the vessels.

As described in other reports and conversations, several of the features that set SafeBoats apart from others are: Hull safety design and performance design. Specifically, the patent held and relevant design for the full vessel collar flotation system coupled with the sealed and chambered hull makes for a level of redundant safety that no other builder presently offers. In essence, either system could fully fail, yet the vessel would be safe to return the crew to harbor. The collar system also offers a significant level of inherent ballistic protection-this too a feature unparalleled without adding of armoring. The (patented) performance fin system allows the vessel to perform with a significant level of stability and quick turn ratio that others can not provide when further added to the 3-4% slip ratio (other vessels fall in the 10-13% hull slip ratio). Slip ration refers to the amount of "effort" need for the vessel to move through the water, come onto plane etc.

These points coupled with a doubled hull (which will now allow continued homeland security patrols through 20ftx20ftx1ft thick slabs of ice), jet propulsion, a lowerable divers stern transom, visual surveillance systems, a self righting feature and operability in a 15ft surf state makes this a vessel apparently unchallenged for safety of divers and crew.
