

PROCUREMENT HISTORY
 The Department of Aviation (DOA) both O'Hare and Midway utilize city owned equipment to test the level of friction (Coefficient of Friction) to ensure that runway pavement is at a safe level for aircraft operations. To ensure this equipment provides accurate measurements the equipment must be calibrated annually by a third party who provides a certificate of calibration. In the event of issues regarding the condition of the pavement, these results of calibration tests are furnished to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB).
 On a weekly basis friction measurements are taken for maintenance and base lining purposes, however during adverse weather events additional readings are taken as to advise the airlines/FAA of the conditions of the runways.
 If the units are not maintained and calibrated properly it could lead to incorrect test results which could lead to dangerous runway conditions/accidents.

ESTIMATED COST
 Per Vendor's Proposal. DOA estimates spending at about \$15,000 to \$20,000 per year.

SCHEDULE REQUIREMENTS
 The FAA requires test units be calibrated annually per FAA AC 150/5200-30B. This contract will also be used to provide parts and service as necessary to the machines as well as provide training on an annual basis to the airport operations personnel on how to operate the equipment. DOA is requesting a Five year contract with no extensions.

 Dynatest is the sole provider of calibration as well as parts, service and training for Dynatest and K J Law Constant Friction Measuring Equipment (CFM). Dynatest purchased K J Law approximately 6 years ago and renamed the company Dynatest.





The Department of Aviation (DOA) requests approval for a sole source contract with Dynatest Consulting Inc. to provide calibration, parts and service for Dynatest Runway Friction Testing (RFT) Equipment.

Pursuant to the attached letter of exclusivity only Dynatest can provide the annual calibration along with training, parts and service required to keep the units in operating condition. The units must be calibrated annually pursuant to FAA Advisory Circular 150/5200-30B. The friction of the runway is measured on a weekly basis along with additional measurements during adverse weather to ensure the runway surface is safe for aircraft operations.

The friction results are conveyed to the airlines and FAA and can be particularly important in the event of an accident to determine if the condition of the runway pavement had an impact on the incident.



1.1. MINORITY AND WOMEN BUSINESS ENTERPRISES

It is the policy of the City of Chicago that local businesses certified as Minority Business Enterprises (MBE) and Women Business Enterprises (WBE) in accordance with Section 2-92-450 of the Municipal Code of Chicago and Regulations Governing Certification of Minority and Women-owned Businesses shall have the maximum opportunity to participate fully in the performance of all City contracts.

The Chief Procurement Officer has determined that the nature of the services to be provided under this contract are such that neither direct nor indirect subcontracting opportunities will be practicable or cost-effective. Therefore, there will be no stated goals for MBE/WBE participation resulting from this contract. This determination is being made pursuant to Section 2-92-450 of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

Scope of Services

Runway Friction Tester Calibration, Service and Training

The contractor shall furnish labor, parts, tools, services, transportation, support and all other items required for the inspection, calibration, repair and training on Friction Testing units owned and operated by the City of Chicago Department of Aviation.

Unit Calibration

Equipment necessary to perform calibration will be shipped in advance to an O'Hare International Airport facility and stored in a secure garage area until technicians arrive. Each unit takes approximately eight hours to inspect and calibrate. The unit cost for calibration includes all travel, equipment, lodging and materials to perform the calibration. Units will be calibrated to standards set by the manufacturer and certificates of calibration will be provided by vendor to the city.

Service to Dynatest Manufactured Equipment

On Site: A technician will review the current status of the Dynatest manufactured equipment and replace any parts that may be deficient or have reached the end of their expected life cycle. The onsite service will be subject to travel time to and from work site (at an hourly rate) as well as time on site actually performing repairs unless the technician is already on site for calibration. If the technician is not already on site and is making a trip specifically to perform the repair, then the travel costs and subsistence will be in accordance with the City of Chicago travel guidelines. Dynatest will be responsible for equipment related to the friction measuring function only and will not be responsible for identifying or repairing any deficiencies with the vehicle or its running gear. Factory labor will be compensated on an hourly basis for hours actually worked.

At the Factory: Once the equipment arrives at the factory a technician will review the current status of the Dynatest manufactured equipment and replace any parts that may be deficient or have reached the end of their expected life cycle. Dynatest will be responsible for equipment related to the friction measuring function only and will not be responsible for identifying or repairing any deficiencies with the vehicle or its running gear. Factory labor will be compensated on an hourly basis for hours actually worked.

Shipping

For repairs that the city or contractor choose to have made at the factory, the contractor will arrange for round trip shipping to and from the factory to O'Hare International Airport. The price for shipping the friction testing unit will be contractor cost. The contractor will provide copies of the shipping companies invoice to substantiate payment.

Parts

The contractor has provided a parts pricing list. Parts will be provided at list price and include shipping.

Guarantee

The calibration and or repair/service of the units are guaranteed for one year. The contractor will make any necessary corrections related to the calibration and any repairs/service within one year of the original calibration /repair service at no cost to the City of Chicago.

Training

Dynatest will provide eight hours per unit of hands on training. This training will be focused on the proper operation and maintenance of the runway friction tester (RFT). The training will be consistent with the outline in Federal Aviation Administration Advisory Circular (AC) 5320-12C but will not include a classroom session. Certificates of Completion will be provided to those who have had their training updated. All travel, subsistence, training materials and labor are included in the training costs.

Dynatest is pleased to provide the following proposal for a 5 year calibration/service/training proposal.

Calibration

Our technicians (2) will fly into O'Hare and spend two days calibrating the two O'Hare units and one additional day for the MDW unit. The MDW unit needs to be brought to the O'Hare facility for this work effort. O'Hare will need to provide a secure garage area for our technicians to work in. Each unit will be reviewed and calibrated. The calibration effort will take approximately three days – roughly 8 hours per day/unit.

The calibration equipment will be shipped to your facility prior to our technicians arriving and then shipped out when the calibration is complete.

Service to Dynatest Manufactured Equipment

The technician will review the current status of the Dynatest manufactured equipment and replace any parts in the parts list below which are deficient. Which parts may require replacement cannot be determined until the unit is inspected and calibrated.

Dynatest will **NOT** review the vehicle nor it's running gear for any deficiencies during this work effort. Should any deficiencies be identified they will be brought to the attention of the airport staff.

The 2008 parts prices attached are included for reference in case any items need to be replaced on the units. Parts prices are adjusted annually and will be adjusted each year during the five year program.

Training

Dynatest will provide 8 hours per unit of hands on training with the airport staff. This training will be an in vehicle training focused on the proper operation and maintenance of the RFT. While this training will be consistent



with the outline in FAA AC 5320-12C, it will **not** include a classroom session. Certificates of training will be provided after the course for those who have had their training updated. Midway operators will be required to attend the session at Ohare. Efforts will be made to accommodate the shift personnel within the eight hours per unit.

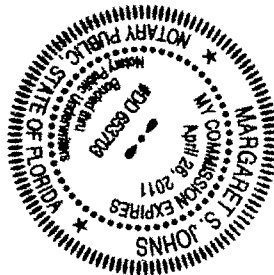

G. The Disclosing Party has not withheld or reserved any disclosures as to economic interests in the Disclosing Party, or as to the Matter, or any information, data or plan as to the intended use or purpose for which the Applicant seeks City Council or other City agency action.

For purposes of the certifications in H.1. and H.2. below, the term "affiliate" means any person or entity that, directly or indirectly: controls the Disclosing Party, is controlled by the Disclosing Party, or is, with the Disclosing Party, under common control of another person or entity. Indicia of control include, without limitation: interlocking management or ownership; identity of interests among family members; shared facilities and equipment; common use of employees; or organization of a business entity following the ineligibility of a business entity to do business with the federal government or a state or local government, including the City, using substantially the same management, ownership, or principals as the ineligible entity.

H.1. The Disclosing Party is not delinquent in the payment of any tax administered by the Illinois Department of Revenue, nor are the Disclosing Party or its affiliates delinquent in paying any fine, fee, tax or other charge owed to the City. 




