



NEW CHANGES TO THE DUNS# Federal Government Unique Entity Identification (UEI)

Effective April 4, 2022: The federal government transitioned from **DUNS** to **UEI**. DUNS numbers will not be required after April 4, 2022.

How to Receive a UEI? Entities must register in the SAM.gov system to receive a UEI.

A unique Entity ID (UEI) allows entities to:

- Apply, Access, and Receive Federal Grant Awards and Procurements
- Submit Invoices and Receive Payment
- Subaward Reporting

Existing and New Contracts: The City will incorporate the new UEI requirement in the City's iSupplier system in July 2022. **All Delegate Agencies** will be required to enter the UEI in the new Site Location Form.
