Re: Political Activity

Dear [REDACTED]:

It has recently come to our attention that you are a registered candidate for the elected office of [REDACTED]. I am writing to inform you that, as an employee of the [REDACTED], your candidacy is prohibited by Section 2-92-410 of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

Section 2-92-410 of the Municipal Code (see enclosed), entitled "Political Activity," states in relevant part:

Neither the Purchasing Agent nor any member of the Commission on Human Relations nor any employee of the Department of Purchases, Contracts and Supplies, the Department of Revenue, the Building Board of Appeals, or the Commission on Human Relations shall engage in political activity as defined in Chapter 2-156 of the Municipal Code of Chicago....  
(Emphasis added.)

Section 2-156-010(s)(6) of the Municipal Code (see enclosed) specifically states that "political activity" means "becoming a candidate for, or campaigning for, an elective public office in an election."

Clearly, your running in the [REDACTED] for election to [REDACTED] while an employee of the [REDACTED] is prohibited by Section 2-92-410 of the Municipal Code.


