In 2019 we did our First Annual Community Cultural Arts event and we held a "Men Cook Too" competition that was widely received by the community.

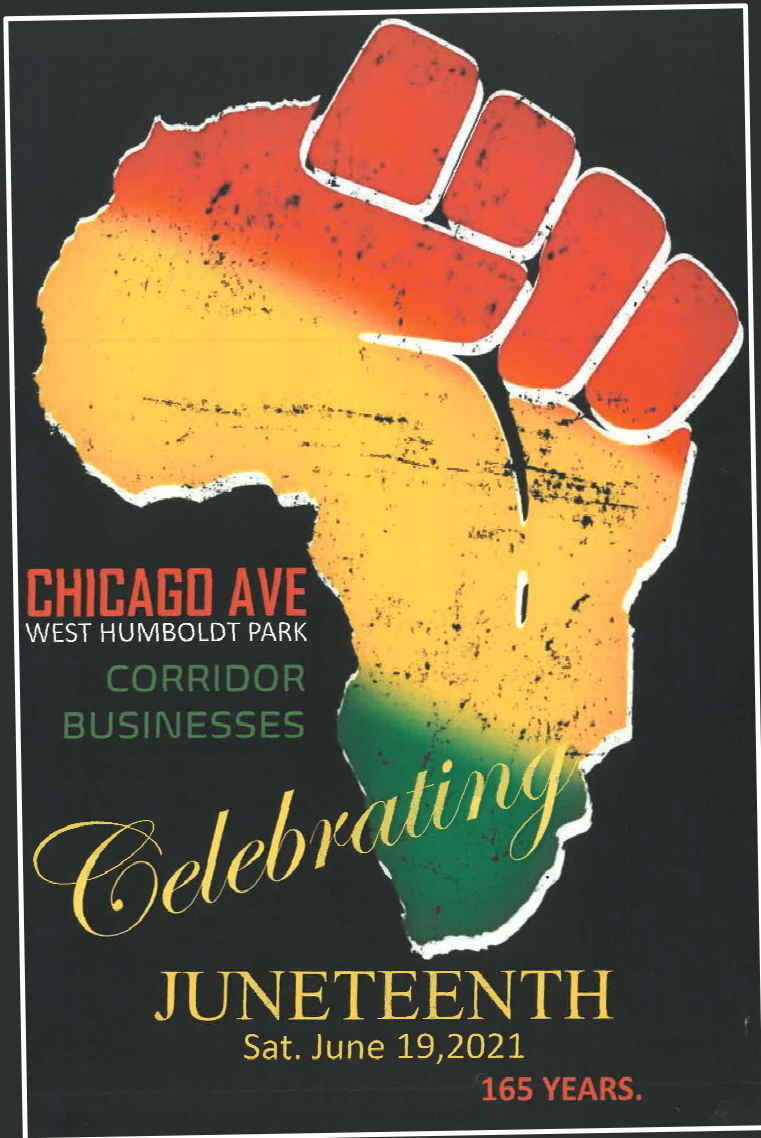
Because of COVID, this year things have been scaled back. We will be partnering with CAAPS and hosting the Cultural Arts piece in August/September.
