ORDER FINDING VIOLATION OF COMMISSION FINAL ORDER

12626 S. Racine

Chicago, IL 60643

On <u>December 6, 2000</u>, the Chicago Commission on Human Relations entered a Final Order finding Respondents <u>T.E.M.R. Jackson Rental & Tony Jackson</u> ("Respondents") liable for violating the Chicago Fair Housing Ordinance. In that Final Order, the Commission ordered Respondents to pay \$21,620 plus interest in damages to Complainant <u>Vernell Barnett</u> ("Complainant"), and to pay the City of Chicago a fine of <u>\$500</u>. As the Final Order stated, Commission Reg. 250.210 requires that parties comply with the Final Order within 31 days.

On <u>March 2, 2001</u>, Complainant filed a letter seeking enforcement of the Final Order, stating that Respondents had not complied with it. The Commission issued a briefing order which gave Respondents until <u>March 23, 2001</u> to respond to the motion and to explain whether they had complied with the Final Order. Respondents did not respond.

Accordingly, the Commission GRANTS Complainant's request to enforce the Final Order of the Commission. Respondent has not complied and more than 31 days have passed since the entry of the Final Order. Therefore, pursuant to Regulation 250.220, the Commission shall send this case to the Office of Corporation Counsel to seek enforcement of the Final Order in state court. Further, pursuant to §5-08-130 and to Regulation 250.220, the Commission fines Respondents an additional \$500 for their failure to comply with the Final Order within 31 days, as ordered.
