As I announced at last month's meeting, the Board plans to consider at a future public meeting amendments to its Rules of Procedure that govern its handling of disciplinary matters. An updated draft of the proposed amendments will be posted on the Board's website. Questions or comments may be submitted to the attention of Executive Director Max Caproni by April 30, 2019.

The general orders and other directives issued by the Superintendent of Police during the previous month are listed in the books made available at this evening's meeting and are posted on the Police Departments's website.

The next item is the Superintendent's report to the Board.

SUPERINTENDENT JOHNSON: Good evening. I'm pleased to share a few updates on our ongoing efforts towards meaningful, long-term reform and compliance with the consent decree.

Over the past six weeks we've hosted a series of conversations in each of our districts to collaboratively a community policing strategic plan

for each of the communities that we serve.

we've also held productive meetings with the federally-appointed independent monitoring team to help gain a mutual understanding of the oversight and evaluation process during this period of reform.

Planning and implementation efforts are also underway in several key areas of the consent decree, including training, supervision, and accountability. We will continue sharing our progress towards sustainable reforms and consent decree compliance throughout this process.

That concludes my report.

PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Thank you.

I will now call upon those members of public who signed up in advance to speak. When your name is called, please step up to the microphone. We ask that you limit your comments to two minutes.

The first speaker is Elihu K. Blanks.

MR. BLANKS: Hello. Two minutes, okay. Let's try.

The margins of a territory can be aware friction and uncertainty exists. This is why I



asked the Third District's southern border be extended south one block to encompass the Jewel shopping center at 75th and Stony Island, where violence, drug sales, and crime potential exists in my community.

Third District is more home to this area because they're at 67th and South Chicago, whereas Fifth District is home to 100 on 111th Street. So because this border at Jewel's, criminals know this is a border. It's not constantly covered by one or the other districts. I think, with my community around me, criminals take advantage of that.

We've seen crime there before and we've acted on it. We've asked Jewel's to increase security, and I'm going to lose my two minutes.

But I ask that border be pushed south. Or if you can't push it south, at least tell one district to cover the south end or the north end so that somebody is always there to get our back.

One more thing. I'm a cyclist. I bike downtown every day back and forth, wintertime, summertime, and everything. Please have the mounted patrols on the south side of Lake Front Trail. Because when I cross over Navy Pier, I see



them on the north side with the paramedics. I

don't see you guys on the south side too much. I

would love to see you guys mounted riding the south

side. Not just in your cars and police vans

sitting there, but riding with us. Those are my

points, and thanks for hearing me out.

MR. O'MALLEY: Wait a second. I have got a question. When you say mounted, you mean the bike patrol? Not the mounted patrol. You mean the bike patrol.

MR. BLANKS: I mean cyclists. They're there once in a blue moon. But they are not there as constantly as when I go to the north, when I go up to Diversey.

PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Superintendent.

SUPERINTENDENT JOHNSON: Do me a favor, can you give your information to that officer in the back and we will talk off line.

PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Thank you.

MR. O'MALLEY: Thank you.

PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Mr. Grier.

MR. GRIER: Good evening. So I am here, as many times in the past, to address an issue. And we feel that this is a very important public safety



issue.

The issue before us is over the course of the past several months, years, there has been an allotment of bodies, young women of color in the urban side, south side, west side, that have turned up in garages, turned up in alleys, turned up in garbage cans.

We need the language to begin to change.

And, Chief Johnson, we need this language to change. Because the reports, especially from the murder accountability commission, Free and First International is my organization, and we believe that there is a serial killer in Chicago that is on the loose.

Their findings have said that there is an excessive pattern, strangulation, asphyxiation.

More than 50 unsolved cases, for those who don't know, of women of color whose bodies have been found. Chicago Police doesn't want to go that far to say that there is a potential serial killer on the loose, but we are suggesting, Chief Johnson, that even if you don't make that determination, that the language has to start to be out there for public safety purposes.

we need public service announcements, 1 2 number one. We are asking for a task force to be put together to start researching and investigating 3 that. Going to the spring, going into the summer, 4 5 we would prefer to have the information out there 6 for the public to dissimulate, rather than see the 7 body count of young woman to continue to rise. 8 50 cases is too much. We need 9 accountability post haste. It's got to stop. It's 10 got to stop. And we're seeing it more and more 11 every day. All right? Fifty bodies. Fifty cases 12 unresolved to date. 13 MS. ZOPP: Thank you. 14 PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Next speaker, EvAngel 15 YHWHnewBN. Next speaker, John Catanzara, Jr. 16 17 Next speaker, Robert More. 18 MR. MORE: 19 20

MR. MORE: It is April 11, 2019, Robert J.

More, here on behalf of the executive committee

Vincent St. Michael, the archangel. We're moving

up to the first public and presidential debate.

And I have just legions of issues here, but I'm

trying to work this whatever, it's 24 minutes

throughout the year, to get maximum benefit over

Superintendent Johnson, here's -- if you have nothing to hide, the track record of individuals sitting in that seat or not sitting in the seat since the investigation of Bland, Young and Spencer murders -- I already only got a minute and a half left already, but that is raising suspicions. And to dispel those suspicions, a couple things. Will you start wearing a wire?

Number two, if you're afraid of getting murdered, and that justification would be entirely legitimate because so many people in the position you're in who have actually started bearing the burdens of the office have ended up murdered. That's just the way it goes down. Okay. John F. Kennedy, Terrence Eeky (phonetic), Pat Tillman.

You stand up against -- you go back to
1915 in the Jewish ritual murder trial of beliefs.
There were seven percipient knowledge witnesses, a
night watchman and six children, four of whom ended
up dead a month through the trial. The three
little children -- their teeth from chattering
because they stood up against world (inaudible).
They saw what police did, they had the testimony to



put the guy away, and they ended up with a hung jury. And that was the last Jewish ritual murder trial.

The point is you're invited, if you can't find someone more Roman's 14 rhinoceros-like to follow me around, and then they'll have to kill me to kill you. That invitation until you can find -- get the most rhinoceros-like, Romans 12, 13, 14, and follow that person around.

But you got to bear the burden of the office to save your soul. Everyone in this room as far as I know is a (inaudible) presumed reprobate. I know I definitely was in that position at least February 5 of 2000. I don't know where I am now. But my first obligation is to speak the truth in charity, and to have no part of any work of darkness. And to be not overcome by evil, but to overcome evil with good. Everyone standing in this office --
