





Figure 3.10: Sloped River Edge

Chicago River Design Guidelines

- Required setback
- Character zones
- Improvements within the required setback
 - \circ Multi-use paths
 - Public access, gathering areas & seating, and signage
 - Landscaping & lighting River edge treatments
- Improvements outside of required setback



Chicago River Design Guidelines

- Projects should incorporate menu items
- Arranged into 3 categories
 - Nature
 - Recreation
 - Connectivity


