Dear UFF Chiefs and Speakers:

For those of you who have attended the Urban Fire Forum in the past, you know that we have arranged airport pickups for you through a private contractor. In most cases that has worked well, but in some cases it has not and chiefs/speakers did not connect with their drivers. Due to last-minute flight delays, cancellations, etc., it is complicated to arrange individual pickups for a group this size. Invariably each year people are left sitting at the airport trying to locate their driver. Therefore, this year we will be handling airport pickups and returns a little different.

When you arrive at the airport (Boston Logan) please go to the Lyft or Uber lot (if you use these services) and take a car directly to the hotel.
