

CLEAR PATH RELIEF PILOT PROGRAM

BENEFITS:

- Pay off the original fine amount for tickets issued in the last 3 years and all older eligible debt will be waived
- 50% reduction of new tickets issued 365 days from enrollment date, if paid timely
- New unpaid tickets will not be assessed penalties until after December 31, 2023

ELIGIBILITY:

- Must have existing vehicle-related debt; AND
- Reside in a household currently enrolled in Utility Billing Relief (UBR); OR
- Have a household income less than or equal to 300% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines

EXCLUSIONS:

 Expired meter tickets, including any penalties are not eligible for waiver or reduction and must be paid as part of this program
