<u>ORDER</u>

The Commission having considered the appeal of RIVER-LITES, LTD., MARK DELIA, PRESIDENT, from the order

of Suspension of the Mayor, as Local Liquor Control Commissioner of the City of Chicago, entered and taken

OCTOBER 3, 2006, and the Commission having reviewed the said appeal and now being fully advised in the premises,

DOTH FIND:

- A) That the Mayor, as Local Liquor Control Commissioner has proceeded in the manner provided by law.
- B) That the findings of the Local Liquor Control Commissioner as set forth in the order of suspension are supported by substantial evidence in the light of the whole record.
- C) That the order of suspension is supported by the findings.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED That the order suspending the liquor license of the

appellant for SEVEN (7) days is AFFIRMED.
