ORDER

The Commission having considered the appeal of RACINE FOOD & LIQUOR, INC., YASER SALAM, PRESIDENT, from the order of revocation of the Mayor, as Local Liquor Control Commissioner of the City of Chicago, entered and taken DECEMBER 8, 2006 and the Commission having reviewed the said appeal and the transcript of proceedings taken before the Mayor, as Local Liquor Control Commissioner and now being full advised in the premises, DOTH FIND:

- A) That the Mayor, as Local Liquor Control Commissioner has proceeded in the manner provided by law.
- B) That the findings of the Local Liquor Control Commission as set forth in the order of revocation are supported by substantial evidence in the light of the whole record.
- C) That the order or revocation is supported by the findings of the Local Liquor Control Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADUDGED That the order revoking the liquor license of the appellant is

AFFIRMED.

Pursuant to Section 154 of the Illinois Liquor Control Act, a petition for rehearing may be filed with this commission within TWENTY (20) days after service of this order. If any party wishes to pursue an administrative review action in the Circuit Court, the petition for rehearing must be filed with this commission within TWENTY (20) days after service of this order as such petition is a jurisdictional prerequisite to the administrative review.
