MAYOR LIGHTFOOT ANNOUNCES AILEEN VELAZQUEZ TO SERVE AS CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICER FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PROCUREMENT SERVICES

CHICAGO – Mayor Lori E. Lightfoot today announced Aileen Velazquez as the next Chief Procurement Officer of the Department of Procurement Services (DPS). Velazquez is an experienced strategic sourcing procurement leader with an excellent record of contract negotiations implementation and governance in Chicago. This appointment is subject to City Council approval.
