

Alderman Arena asked for an estimated amount of refuse tonnage and the associated cost that would be reduced through the introduction of city-wide recycling.

Streets and Sanitation estimated that the 2013 waste disposal account would need to be funded at 2012 levels in case no recycling expansions were to occur. At that funding level currently 40% of residential homes receive recycling collection services. In order to estimate potential savings following a city-wide expansion of recycling the following assumptions were made:

- 1) The remaining 60% of residential homes would receive recycling collection services for an average of 60% of the year,
- 2) The recycling rate in those areas will be 15%.

Using those assumptions DSS estimates a reduction of 55,395 tons and a savings of \$2,485,000 by the end of 2013. Because actual recycling participation percentages and rollout timing is not known the Department went with last year's budget of \$41,259,993 to be safe.
