Alderman Raymond Lopez asked for CACC to provide a list of funds donated to the City from private donors over the past year.

Chicago Animal Care and Control accepts donations of non-monetary goods daily from members of the public (a wish list is available on our website). Specialty items like pet waste scoopers, medical supplies and equipment or items specifically assigned to a program are usually donated through larger organizations. Below is a list of some items that were donated in 2018.
