\*\*Rationale - Looked at staffing goal for each locations, taking in to consideration the criteria put forth in the 2012 staffing patterns + the addition of Children's and Teen staff to cover the new program areas, as well as selected locations for expanded adult programming and technology assistance. Need minimum configurations of 8 FTE @ location and above to cover 9-5 and 12-8 shifts.
