The following information is provided in response to requests made by Alderman Brendan Reilly, posed via email, to discuss the proposed 2022 budget.

- 1. Changes in headcount projected for 2022
  - a. PSA has a net increase of 4 positions from FY21 to FY22, across all funds.
- 2. Number of vacancies and breakdown for 2022
  - a. PSA has 73 vacancies going into FY22. The breakout of these vacancies can be found in the 2022 Department Budget Hearing Document book provided to aldermen.
- 3. Number of vacancies being cut what positions (job titles) are being eliminated?
  - a. A total of 3 vacancies were cut from fund 353; those positions are (1) GIS Analyst, (1) Lineman, and (1) Electrical Mechanic
- 4. Number of non-union employees to receive salary increase in 2022 budget
  - a. 61 non-union employees received a 5% increase on 7/16/21 which will carry over to the FY22 budget.
- 5. Description of outsourced services projected for 2022
  - a. IT/Desktop support
- 6. List of savings and cost efficiencies due to zero based budgeting
  - a. Improved grant management by developing a centralized process for all public safety grants.
  - b. Developed new accounts receivable/payables process, including new workflow system to better optimize payment process.
