The following information is provided in response to a question posed at our department's hearing on October 4, 2021, to discuss the proposed 2022 budget.

Chairman Dowell asked for demographic information on appeals filed by applicants to become a Chicago police officer who were disqualified due to the results of a background investigation.

A total of eight (8) appeals have been filed to date. Below is demographic information on these appeals:

- **Gender:** seven males, one female
- **Age:** two applicants are 25 – 29 years old, four are 30 – 34, two are 35 -39
- **Residence:** two live in the 8<sup>th</sup> Ward, two in the 22<sup>nd</sup> Ward, one in the 26<sup>th</sup> Ward, one in the 48<sup>th</sup> Ward, and two live outside the City of Chicago.

Please note that the documents the Police Board receives from the applicant and CPD do not include information on the race or ethnicity of the applicants who are appealing to the Board.
