## Mayor Lori Lightfoot's Chicago Resilient Communities Pilot

## Summary of Applications Received and Applicant Demographics

#### **\*** Executive Summary

- The 3-week application period (Monday, April 25 through Friday, May 13) resulted in more than 176,000 applications across the city of Chicago.
- A high application complete rate (78.4%) and low median time to complete (~27.5 minutes) demonstrate a broadly accessible, low-burden application.
- The vast majority of applicants live in South and West side communities and more than 82% of applicants live in a "high" or "medium" hardship community area, as defined by the UIC Economic Hardship Index
- A majority of applicants were female, Black, have household incomes under the federal poverty line (<100% FPL), and have caregiving responsibilities.
- All 5,000 households who were selected in the lottery have been notified and enrollment is underway. The next public report will share the same household demographics for the final 5,000 households.






