# Community and business friendly bike parking

#### **Community Growth**

Bike corrals increase the visibility of bicycling as a transportation choice and show that a business community is "bike friendly"—that it cares about people who ride bicycles.



#### **Breathe and Walk Easier**

When installed adjacent to sidewalk cafes, corrals provide an additional buffer between people and passing vehicles. Bike corrals can also make the walking environment more welcoming by removing bikes from the sidewalk.

#### **Safer for People Walking & Biking**

When installed near crosswalks and corners, corrals can increase visibility and shorten the crossing distance for pedestrians. When installed adjacent to bike lanes, corrals can decrease the likelihood of "dooring" and the number of cars crossing the bike lane.

of businesses surveyed said that the bike corrals increased foot and bike traffic. 84%

#### **Standard Corral**

## Cost: \$0!

CDOT will install standard bike corrals at no cost to businesses and organizations.



#### **Custom Corral**

Cost: \$1,750 - \$3,000

SSAs, businesses and organizations have the option to fund custom corrals with branding that CDOT will install at no cost, like these in Andersonville and Pilsen:





## **Maintenance Agreement**

The City will require a maintenance agreement for the removal of snow and trash from the corral and curb.
