### **Recap of HIA Process**

#### **6 STEPS OF THE HIA PROCESS**

1. Screening Determines if an HIA is needed or valuable

2. Scoping Identifies the community impacted, potential health effects and key stakeholders

3. Assessment Uses gualitative and guantitative methods to assess current health conditions and potential impacts

4. Recommendations Provides solutions to lessen or enhance health effects

5. Reporting Disseminates findings to key stakeholders, community members and decision makers

#### 6. Monitoring and Evaluation

Tracks changes in health risks, health outcomes and changes in decision making

# What is a Health Impact Assessment?

- A health impact assessment is a process that helps determine the potential effects of a proposed policy, plan, or project on health.
- **Community members** are important stakeholders in the health impact assessment process.
- We are committed to applying environmental justice and racial equity principles and practices in this process.




### **Background:** RMG/Southside Recycling

- Reserve Management Group (RMG) is an Ohio based metal recycling company
- Purchased General Iron, then operating in Lincoln Park, in 2019
- Seeking permit for Southside Recycling at 11600 S. Burley
- Has operated recycling facilities in the ward for **30+ years**
- Would accept scrap metal, including end of life vehicles, for **processing and recycling**
- CDPH is conducting this HIA to inform our decision on whether to issue a large recycling facility permit
