



BACP PUBLIC VEHICLE INDUSTRY NOTICE

Identifying a City of Chicago Licensed Livery Vehicle

- The license term for a City of Chicago Licensed Livery Vehicle is January 1 to December 31.
- The range of City of Chicago livery license numbers is **7000 to 9999** and **70000 to 73000**.
- Livery vehicle licensing information is posted at [Chicago.gov/PublicVehicles](https://chicago.gov/PublicVehicles)

For the 2024 license term, a **CITY OF CHICAGO LIVERY VEHICLE** must display:

1. A **2024 IL SOS license plate** issued specifically to a City of Chicago licensed livery in a color differentiating a City livery from a non-City livery. The number on the IL SOS license plate matches the City of Chicago livery license number.

AND

2. A **2024 BACP-issued livery license certificate “hard” card** which lists: the license holder name; license number; name of the president/owner; year/make/model of vehicle; VIN #; and vehicle color.

New for 2024:

- (1) *The 2024 livery license “hard” card must be displayed on the passenger side dashboard.*
- (2) *BACP eliminated the windshield livery license sticker.*

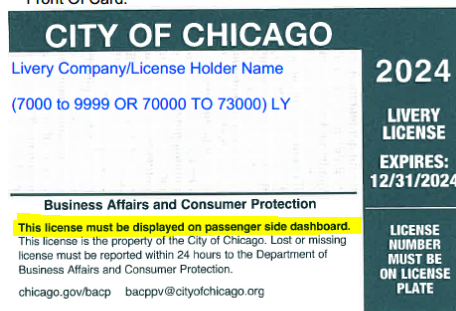
AND

The driver operating a **CITY OF CHICAGO LICENSED LIVERY** must produce upon request:

3. A current **BACP-issued public chauffeur license** which includes the chauffeur’s photo, name, license number, and license expiration date. A Livery or Taxi Chauffeur may operate a City of Chicago Livery Vehicle.

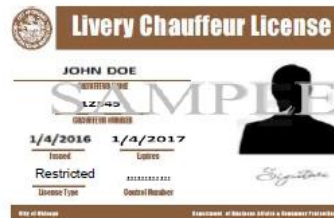
