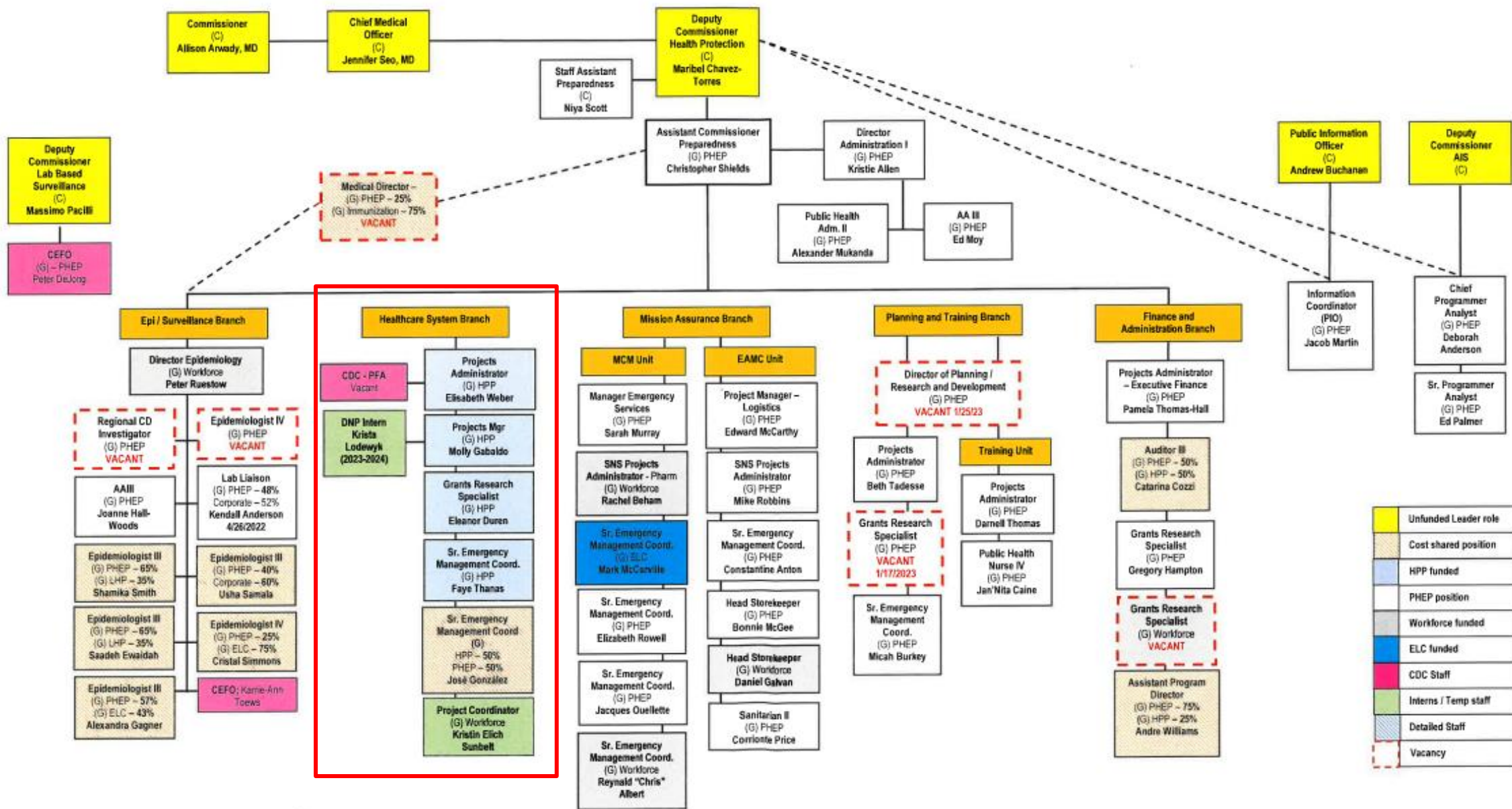

Background

CDPH "Bioterrorism Program" started in 1999

Minimal funding at that time (600K); 4 staff

CDC funded only

Congressional appropriation in 2001 (post 9/11)

Improve PH infrastructure

Chicago designated as a directly funded city

Dramatically increased and then decreased \$\$

CDC and Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) →ASPR

Continuous growth and increased capability

HPP FUNDING

9% decrease in funding since FY 2013

Primary Goals



Assure healthcare system coordination during public health emergencies through shared preparedness planning, training, exercise, and response with Chicago's 35 hospitals, 400+ healthcare partners, the Chicago Healthcare Coalition and regional and statewide partners



Monitor regional medical surge capabilities for both real and scheduled public health and citywide events



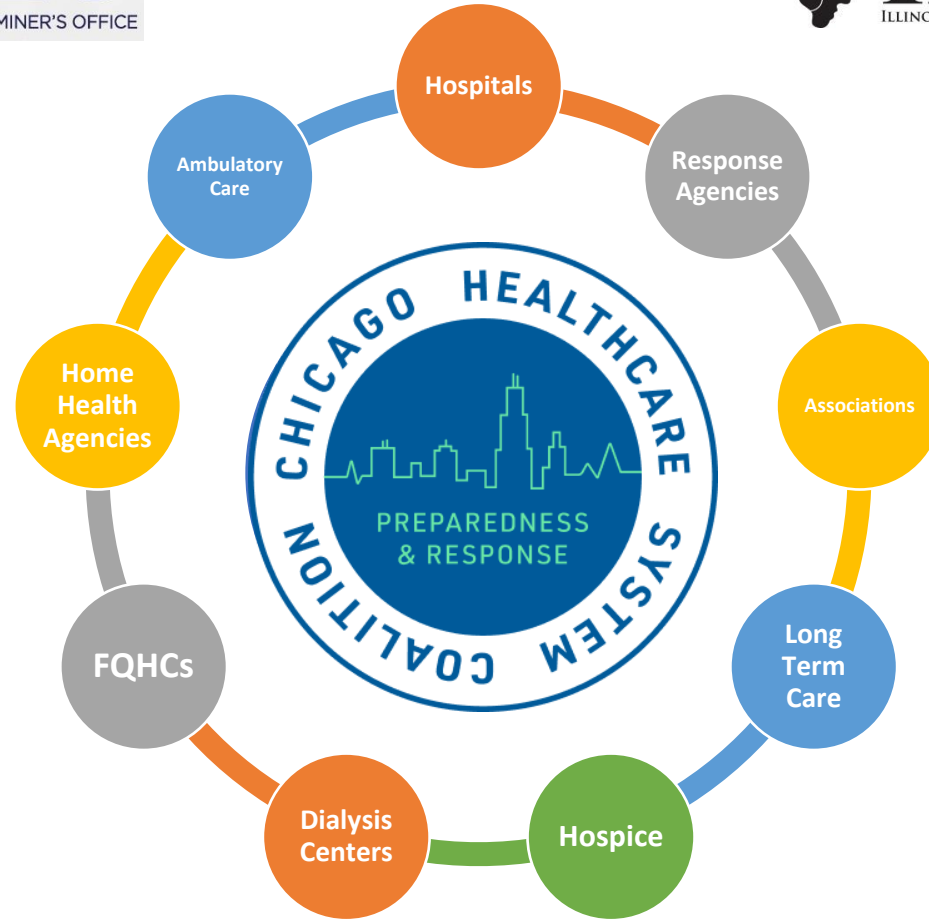
Build and maintain local cache of emergency medical supplies and coordinate receipt of assets from the federal Strategic National Stockpile (SNS) (i.e. ventilators, PPE, burn and medical supplies)



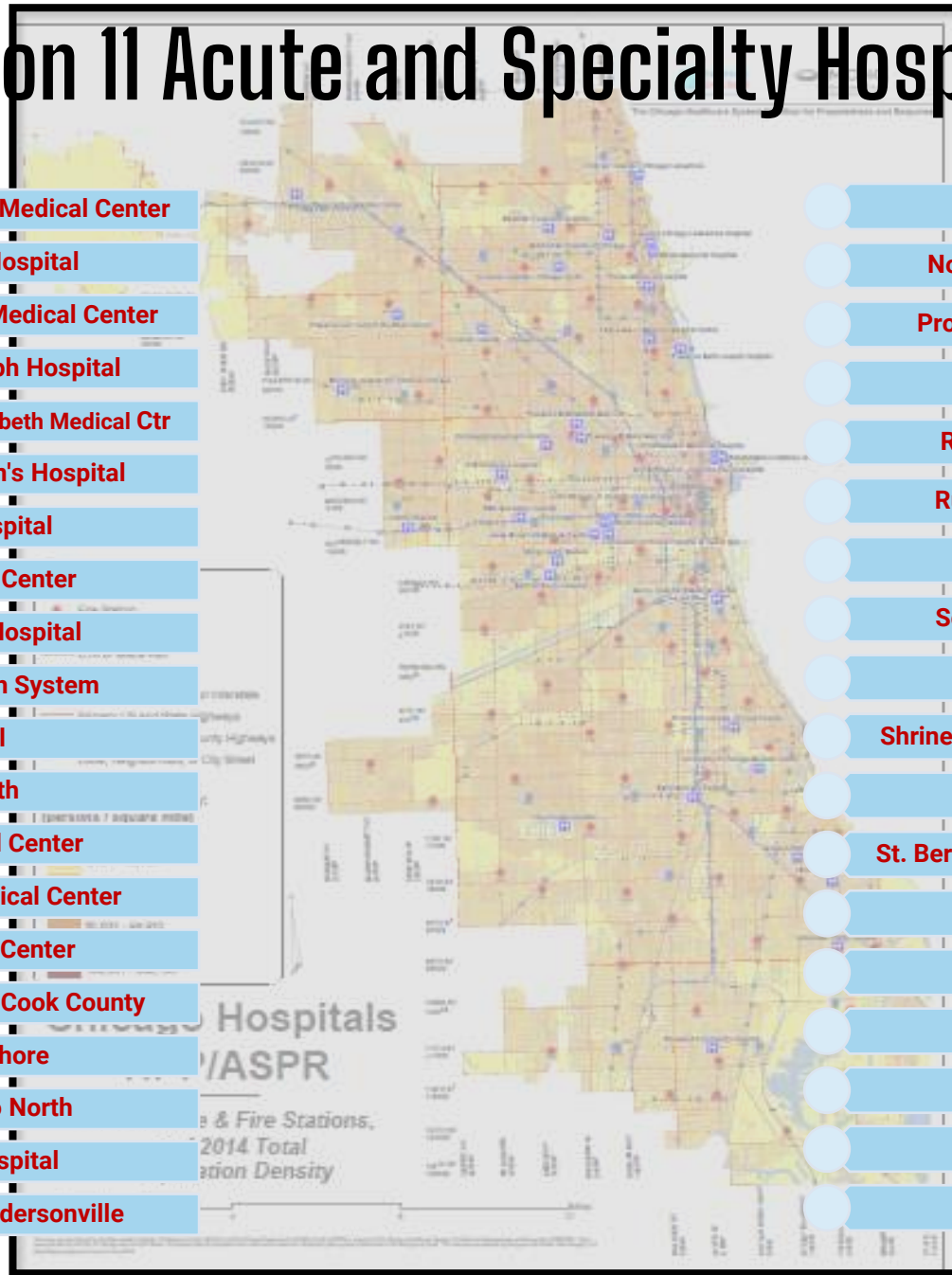
Collaborate with local, regional, and state authorities before and during emergencies to coordinate patient movement, patient tracking, and to share critical information with healthcare partners

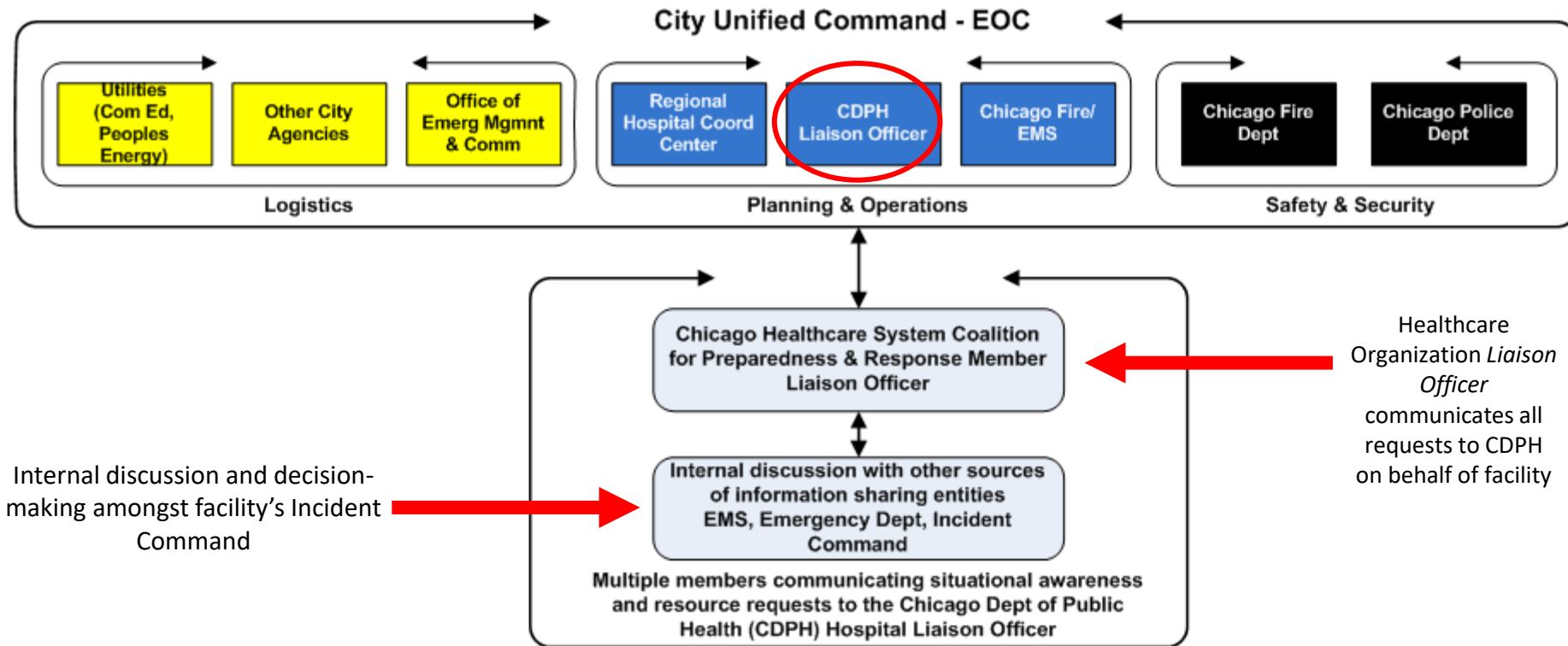
