The major features of this project includes hot spot soil remediaiton of contaminatred soils, construction of storm water detention system as required by City Ordinance, placing fencing around the proparty as required by City Ordinance, and parkway improvements as required by CDOT.

The DOE JOC Program was developed to remove Underground Storage Tanks throughout the City as well as the remediaiton of contaminated sites in support of the Brownfield Redevelopment Program. The Scope of Work and size of the project described above fits inside the initial design of the DOE JOC Program.
