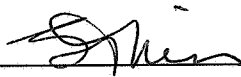

(X) PROCUREMENT HISTORY

The City of Chicago standardized its Geographical Information Systems (GIS) along the leading technical standard provided by ESRI in 2000. Since then, a term agreement allowed GIS users from all 50 departments to purchase the "ARC" suite of software as needed.

ESRI continues to serve as the GIS platform throughout the City of Chicago. This new Master Purchasing Agreement provides a fresh software licensing list and will allow development to continue without loss of support. The scope of the agreement includes a pricing schedule for off-the-shelf software, technical customer support, online training credit pricing, and software support.

(X) ESTIMATED COST

Renewal of existing City of Chicago software licenses in 2005 are expected to be \$175,000. Several departments have plans to purchase additional server-side software this year. Our overall purchases of desktop level software is trending down. The expenditure history is listed below.

**MASTER PURCHASE AGREEMENT
Contract No. 2004MPA4029**

This Master Purchase Agreement ("MPA" or "Agreement") is between the governmental body ("Licensee") identified below and Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. ("ESRI"). The Agreement enables Licensee to acquire ESRI geographic information system Software, services, Documentation, Data, or hardware over a defined period of time.

This Agreement is comprised of the following documents:

8. ESRI Client Site Training Terms and Conditions, E207 11/04

This Agreement constitutes the sole and entire agreement of the parties as to the subject matter set forth herein and supersedes any previous agreements, understandings, and arrangements between the parties relating to such subject matter. Any modification(s) or amendment(s) to this Agreement must be in writing and signed by an authorized representative of each party.

**ARTICLE 1—DEFINITIONS**

Definitions—As used herein, the following words, phrases, or terms in this License Agreement shall have the following meanings:

- (a) "Software" means the actual copy of all or any portion of ESRI's proprietary geographic information system (GIS) software technology, computer software code, components, dynamic link libraries (DLLs), and programs delivered on any media, including, but not limited to, alpha, beta, prerelease, restricted version(s), or final commercial release provided in source, object, or executable code format(s), inclusive of backups, updates, service packs, sample code, or merged copies permitted hereunder or subsequently supplied under this License Agreement.
- (b) "Data" means any ESRI or third party data vendor(s) digital data set(s) including, but not limited to, geographic, vector data coordinates, raster, reports, or associated tabular attributes in ESRI GIS software compatible format(s) supplied under this License Agreement.
- (c) "Documentation" means all of the printed and digital materials including, but not limited to, user documentation, training documentation, or technical information and briefings supplied under this License Agreement.
- (d) "License Manager" means the nondestructive license management software program or hardware key, or similar copy protection mechanism, which controls the distribution of the licensed number of Software copies to requesting end user(s) of Licensee.

ARTICLE 2—INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS AND RESERVATION OF OWNERSHIP

The Software, Data, and Documentation are owned by ESRI and its licensor(s) and are protected by United States laws and applicable international laws, treaties, and conventions regarding intellectual property or proprietary rights, inclusive of trade secrets. ESRI and its licensor(s) retain all rights, title, and ownership not granted herein to all copies of the Software, Data, and Documentation licensed under this License Agreement. From the date of receipt, Licensee agrees to use reasonable effort to protect the Software, Data, and Documentation from unauthorized use, reproduction, distribution, or publication. All rights not specifically granted in this License Agreement are reserved to ESRI and its licensor(s).

ARTICLE 3—GRANT OF LICENSE

3.1 Grant of License—In consideration of the mutual promises and covenants provided herein and for other good and valuable consideration, and conditioned upon compliance with all of the terms and conditions set forth in this License Agreement including, but not limited to, Article 4, ESRI grants to Licensee a personal, nonexclusive, nontransferable license to

- (a) Use the Software, Data, and Documentation as a single package for Licensee's own internal use only; and
- (b) Access and use any secure ESRI Web site resources made available to Licensee for Licensee's internal use only, provided that Licensee follows ESRI's terms of use policy specified therein. All password or controlled access information provided by ESRI shall be treated as ESRI confidential information.

3.2 Beta License—In the event ESRI accepts Licensee into a current Beta Testing program, Licensee may be provided copies of alpha, beta, and/or prerelease (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Beta") Software for the limited purpose of testing the Beta Software in accordance with the Beta testing policies then in effect. Beta Software and Documentation delivered are confidential and proprietary to ESRI and contain trade secrets, inclusive of unpublished specifications. In consideration of the rights granted herein, Licensee agrees to retain all Beta Software and Documentation provided to Licensee in confidence. Licensee shall maintain all results of testing in confidence and agrees not to disclose to any third party details pertaining to the Beta Software, Documentation, test results, or errors encountered. ESRI reserves the right to determine which Beta Software and Documentation, subsequent interim beta release(s), or patch(es) will be made available to Licensee to test during the term of the License Agreement. Beta Software is subject to change prior to its commercial release and may never be commercially released. Licensee is advised that such Software is not suitable or licensed for full use and accepts all responsibility for use of the same and any results generated.

3.3 Evaluation License—ESRI may from time to time extend a limited term evaluation license(s) under the terms of this License Agreement, for the duration authorized in any supporting documentation supplied by ESRI.

3.4 Consultant Access—Licensee may provide access to the Software, Data, or Documentation to any consultant or contractor of Licensee, provided that the consultant or contractor is using the Software, Data, or Documentation exclusively for the benefit of Licensee. Licensee shall be responsible for compliance by consultants or contractors with the terms and conditions of this License Agreement.

3.5 Commercial Application Service Provider—Use of ESRI Software, Data, or Documentation in a commercial Application Service Provider (ASP) business model is subject to execution of a written ASP license agreement and the payment of the appropriate additional license fees. For purposes of this License Agreement, a commercial ASP means a Licensee who uses ESRI Software, Data, or Documentation for a site or service, operates the site or the service for a profit, and generates revenue by charging for access to the site or service (by selling data, pay-per-view, subscription fee, or similar means).

ARTICLE 4—SCOPE OF USE

4.1 Permitted Uses

- (a) Licensee may (i) install and store copies onto electronic storage device(s) and (ii) only use the Software, Data, and Documentation as described in Exhibit 1 Scope of Use and in accordance with the licensed configuration provided at the time of order, Software registration or License Manager issue.
- (b) Licensee may make one (1) copy of the Software, Data, and Documentation for archival purposes during the term of this License Agreement. Additionally, Licensee may make routine computer backups and implement a redundant Software installation for failover operations during the period the primary site is not operational. The redundant Software installation shall remain dormant except for system maintenance and updating of databases while the primary site is operational.
- (c) Licensee may customize the Software using any (i) macro or scripting language, (ii) open application programming interface (API), or (iii) source or object code libraries, but only to the extent that such customization is described in the Documentation.
- (d) Excluding ESRI Business Information Systems Data and unless there is a statement to the contrary in the metadata, Licensee may use, copy, reproduce, publish, publicly display, or redistribute map images derived from ESRI branded Data in hard-copy or static, electronic formats (i.e., .gif, .tif, etc.) provided that Licensee affixes an attribution statement to the map images acknowledging ESRI or its licensors as the source of the portion(s) of such Data displayed, printed, or plotted. The ESRI branded Data shall not be used separately from ESRI Software. Otherwise, Licensee may use the Data only as described in the Distribution Rights section of the help or metadata files delivered with the Software, Data, and Documentation, or subject to the third party Data vendor's terms. Licensee may use the Data only as described in the Distribution Rights section of the help or metadata files delivered with the Software, Data, and Documentation, or subject to the third party Data vendor's terms.
- (e) Licensee may use, copy, or prepare derivative works of the Documentation supplied in digital format and thereafter reproduce, display, and redistribute the customized documentation only for Licensee's own internal use. The portion(s) of the Documentation supplied in digital format merged with other software and printed or digital documentation shall continue to be subject to the terms and conditions of this License Agreement and shall provide the following copyright attribution notice acknowledging the proprietary rights of ESRI and its licensor(s) in the Documentation supplied in digital format: "Portions of this document include intellectual property of ESRI and its licensor(s) and are used herein under license. Copyright © [*Insert the actual copyright date(s) from the source materials*] ESRI and its licensor(s). All rights reserved."
- (f) Licensee may include ESRI Business Information Systems reports and other output in presentation packages or marketing studies for subsidiaries and customers where the value of the ESRI Business Information Systems report or other Data output is less than twenty percent (20%) of Licensee's total value of the presentation package or marketing study. Full, complete, stand-alone reports created from the ESRI Business Information Systems Software or Data cannot be resold without prior written permission of ESRI Business Information Systems. Licensee's third party customer may only receive reports and maps generated by Licensee and may only use the maps and reports received from Licensee for internal purposes.

4.2 Uses Not Permitted

- (a) Licensee shall not sell; rent; lease; sublicense; lend; assign; time-share; or act as a service bureau or Application Service Provider (ASP) that allows third party access to the Software, Data, and Documentation except as provided herein; or transfer, in whole or in part, access to prior or present versions of the Software, Data, or Documentation, any updates, or Licensee's rights under this License Agreement.

- (b) Licensee shall not redistribute the Software registration number/license authorization file(s).
- (c) Licensee shall not redistribute the Software, in whole or in part, including, but not limited to, extensions, components, or DLLs without the prior written approval of ESRI as set forth in an appropriate redistribution license agreement.
- (d) Licensee shall not reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the Software, Data, or Documentation, except to the extent that such activity is expressly permitted by applicable law notwithstanding this restriction in order to protect ESRI and its licensor(s) trade secrets and proprietary information contained in the Software, Data, or Documentation.
- (e) Licensee shall not make any attempt to circumvent the technological measure(s) (e.g., License Manager, etc.) that controls access to or use of the Software, Data, and Documentation, except to the extent that such activity is expressly permitted by applicable law notwithstanding this restriction.
- (f) Licensee shall not use the Software to transfer or exchange any material where such transfer or exchange is prohibited by copyright or any other law.
- (g) Licensee shall not remove or obscure any ESRI or its licensor(s) patent, copyright, trademark, or proprietary rights notices contained in or affixed to the Software, Data, or Documentation.
- (h) After a reasonable transition period for updating to the most current version of the Software, Licensee shall cease using all prior version(s) of the Software that Licensee has elected to update to the most current version(s) of the Software. When the transition to the most current version(s) of the Software is complete, the quantity of Software licenses in use by Licensee at any given time shall not exceed the total quantity licensed by ESRI in accordance with the licensed configuration on file with ESRI Customer Service.
- (i) With the exception of Server Software application licenses for which such licensed use are contemplated, Licensee shall not provide access to or allow affiliates or other third parties to use the Software, Data, or Documentation in a distributed computing environment. This restriction shall not apply to Section 3.4, Consultant Access.
- (j) Licensee may not distribute or post Data, reports, or other output from ESRI Business Information Systems Software or Data or services on the Internet without the express written consent of ESRI Business Information Systems.

ARTICLE 5—MAINTENANCE

Maintenance consists of Software, Data, or Documentation updates and access to technical support and other benefits specified in the most current applicable ESRI Support Services Policy.

ARTICLE 6—TERM AND TERMINATION

The license granted to Licensee by this License Agreement shall commence upon the acceptance of this License Agreement and shall continue until such time that (i) Licensee elects in writing to discontinue use of the Software, Data, or Documentation and terminates this License Agreement or (ii) either party terminates this License Agreement for a material breach that is not cured within ten (10) days of written notice to the other party, except that termination is immediate for a material breach of a nature that it is impossible to cure. Upon termination of this License Agreement, Licensee shall uninstall, remove, and destroy all Software, Data, and Documentation, and any whole or partial copies, modifications, or merged portions in any form and execute and deliver evidence of such deinstallation and destruction to ESRI.

ARTICLE 7—LIMITED WARRANTIES AND DISCLAIMERS

7.1 Limited Warranties—For a period of ninety (90) days from the later of the date of keycode issuance or date of delivery of the Software, Data, or Documentation to Licensee, ESRI represents and warrants that (i) the unmodified Software will substantially conform to the published Documentation and (ii) the media upon which the Software, Data, and Documentation is provided will be free from defects in materials and workmanship under normal use and service.

7.2 Data Disclaimer—If included under this License Agreement, the Data has been obtained from sources believed to be reliable, but its accuracy and completeness are not guaranteed. The Data may contain some nonconformities, defects, errors, or omissions. **ESRI AND ITS LICENSOR(S) MAKE NO WARRANTY WITH RESPECT TO THE DATA.** Without limiting the generality of the preceding sentence, ESRI and its licensor(s) do not warrant that the Data will meet Licensee's needs or expectations, the use of the Data will be uninterrupted, or that all nonconformities can or will be corrected. ESRI and its licensor(s) are not inviting reliance on this Data, and Licensee should always verify actual Data including, but not limited to, map, spatial, raster, and tabular information.

7.3 High Risk Activities

- (a) The Software, Data, and Documentation are not fault-tolerant and are not designed, manufactured, or intended for use or resale for insurance underwriting or with critical health and safety or online control equipment in hazardous environments that require fail-safe performance, such as in the operation of nuclear facilities, aircraft navigation, or

communication systems, air traffic control, emergency response, terrorism prevention or response, life support, or weapons systems ("High Risk Activities"). ESRI SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIMS ANY EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OF FITNESS FOR HIGH RISK ACTIVITIES.

- (b) To the extent permitted by law, Licensee agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold ESRI, its officers, directors, employees, agents, subcontractors, licensors, successors, and assigns harmless from and against any and all liability, losses, claims, expenses (including attorneys' fees), demands, or damages of any kind, including direct, indirect, special, punitive, incidental, or consequential damages, arising out of or in any way connected with Licensee's use or permitting the use by others of the Software, Data, and vendor's hardware for High Risk Activities. Delivery of the Software, Data, and vendor's hardware does not constitute a waiver of the rights and obligations set forth in this Article.

7.4 General Disclaimer—EXCEPT FOR THE ABOVE EXPRESS LIMITED WARRANTIES, ESRI DISCLAIMS ALL OTHER WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND, EITHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, NONINTERFERENCE, SYSTEM INTEGRATION, AND NONINFRINGEMENT. ESRI DOES NOT WARRANT THAT THE SOFTWARE, DATA, OR DOCUMENTATION WILL MEET LICENSEE'S NEEDS, OR THAT LICENSEE'S OPERATION OF THE SAME WILL BE UNINTERRUPTED OR ERROR FREE, OR THAT ALL NONCONFORMITIES CAN OR WILL BE CORRECTED.

LICENSEE EXPRESSLY ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT ALPHA, BETA, PRERELEASE, RESTRICTED VERSION, SAMPLE CODE, AND EVALUATION SOFTWARE ARE DELIVERED "AS-IS" WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, EITHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, NONINTERFERENCE, SYSTEM INTEGRATION, AND NONINFRINGEMENT. LICENSEE ASSUMES ALL RISK AS TO THE QUALITY AND PERFORMANCE OF THE BETA AND EVALUATION SOFTWARE.

7.4 Exclusive Remedy—Licensee's exclusive remedy and ESRI's entire liability for breach of the limited warranties set forth in this Article 7 shall be limited, at ESRI's sole discretion, to (i) replacement of any defective media; (ii) repair, correction, or a work-around for the Software subject to the ESRI Support Services Policy; or (iii) return of the license fees paid by Licensee for the Software, Data, or Documentation that does not meet ESRI's Limited Warranty, provided that Licensee uninstalls, removes, and destroys all copies of the Software, Data, or Documentation and executes and delivers evidence of such deinstallation and destruction to ESRI.

ARTICLE 8—LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

8.1 Disclaimer of Certain Types of Liability—IN NO EVENT SHALL ESRI OR ITS LICENSOR(S) BE LIABLE TO LICENSEE FOR COSTS OF PROCUREMENT OF SUBSTITUTE GOODS OR SERVICES; LOST PROFITS; LOST SALES OR BUSINESS EXPENDITURES; INVESTMENTS; OR COMMITMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH ANY BUSINESS, LOSS OF ANY GOODWILL, OR FOR ANY INDIRECT, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT OR USE OF THE SOFTWARE, DATA, OR DOCUMENTATION, HOWEVER CAUSED, ON ANY THEORY OF LIABILITY, AND WHETHER OR NOT ESRI OR ITS LICENSOR(S) HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGE. THESE LIMITATIONS SHALL APPLY NOTWITHSTANDING ANY FAILURE OF ESSENTIAL PURPOSE OF ANY LIMITED REMEDY.

8.2 General Limitation of Liability—EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN ARTICLE 9—INFRINGEMENT INDEMNITY, IN NO EVENT WILL ESRI'S TOTAL CUMULATIVE LIABILITY HEREUNDER, FROM ALL CAUSES OF ACTION OF ANY KIND, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, CONTRACT, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE), STRICT LIABILITY, BREACH OF WARRANTY, MISREPRESENTATION, OR OTHERWISE, EXCEED THE AMOUNTS PAID TO ESRI BY LICENSEE FOR SOFTWARE, DATA, OR DOCUMENTATION PURSUANT TO THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT.

8.3 Applicability of Disclaimers and Limitations—Licensee agrees that the limitations of liability and disclaimers set forth in this License Agreement will apply regardless of whether Licensee has accepted the Software, Data, or Documentation or any other product or service delivered by ESRI. The parties agree that ESRI has set its prices and entered into this Agreement in reliance upon the disclaimers and limitations set forth herein, that the same reflect an allocation of risk between the parties (including the risk that a contract remedy may fail of its essential purpose and cause consequential loss), and that the same form an essential basis of the bargain between the parties.

ARTICLE 9—INFRINGEMENT INDEMNITY

9.1 ESRI shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Licensee from and against any loss, liability, cost, or expense, including reasonable attorneys' fees, which may be incurred by Licensee against any claims, actions, or demands by a third party alleging that the Software, Data, or Documentation infringes a U.S. patent, copyright, or trademark provided

- (a) Licensee promptly notifies ESRI in writing of the claim thereof;
- (b) ESRI has sole control of the defense of any actions and negotiations related to the defense or settlement of any claim; and
- (c) Licensee cooperates fully in the defense of the claim.

9.2 If ESRI believes that the Software, Data, or Documentation is or will become the subject of an infringement claim, or in the event that use of the Software, Data, or Documentation is enjoined, ESRI, at its own expense, may either (i) obtain the right for Licensee to continue using the Software, Data, or Documentation or (ii) modify the Software, Data, or Documentation to make it noninfringing while maintaining substantially similar software functionality or data/informational content. If neither of such alternatives is commercially reasonable, the infringing items shall be returned to ESRI and ESRI's sole liability shall be to refund license fees paid by Licensee prorated on a five (5) year straight line depreciation basis beginning from the initial date of delivery.

9.3 ESRI shall have no obligation hereunder to defend Licensee or to pay any resulting costs, damages, or reasonable attorneys' fees for or with respect to any claims, actions, or demands alleging (i) infringement that arises by reason of combination of noninfringing items, however acquired, with any items not supplied by ESRI; (ii) infringement to the extent arising from material alteration of the Software, Data, or Documentation by anyone other than ESRI, its agents, or its contractors; (iii) the direct or contributory infringement of any process patent by Licensee through the use of the Software, Data, or Documentation other than a process patent that is necessarily infringed by the internal processes executed within the Software or Data itself when the Software or Data is executed for its intended purpose; (iv) continued allegedly infringing activity by Licensee after it has been notified of the possible infringement; or (v) continued allegedly infringing activity by Licensee to the extent it arises from failure of Licensee to use the updated or modified Software, Data, or Documentation provided by ESRI for avoiding infringement.

THE FOREGOING STATES THE ENTIRE OBLIGATION OF ESRI WITH RESPECT TO INFRINGEMENT OR ALLEGATION OF INFRINGEMENT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS OF ANY THIRD PARTY.

ARTICLE 10—GENERAL PROVISIONS

10.1 **Future Orders**—All Software, Data, Documentation, or maintenance orders placed within one (1) year of this License Agreement's execution date shall be licensed under the terms of this License Agreement, except that new Software, Data, and Documentation commercially released during that year may require additional terms. Orders placed and Software, Data, and Documentation updates or upgrades provided after that time shall be governed by the then-current General License Terms and Conditions and Exhibit 1, the terms of which will be indicated on ESRI's Web site or included with the Software, Data or Documentation, depending on the method of delivery.

10.2 **Export Control Regulations**—Licensee expressly acknowledges and agrees that Licensee shall not export, reexport, or provide the Software, Data, or Documentation, in whole or in part, to (i) any country to which the United States has embargoed goods; (ii) any person on the U.S. Treasury Department's list of Specially Designated Nationals; (iii) any person or entity on the U.S. Commerce Department's Table of Denial Orders; or (iv) any person or entity where such export, reexport, or provision violates any U.S. export control law or regulation. Licensee shall not export the Software, Data, and/or Documentation or any underlying information or technology to any facility in violation of these or other applicable laws and regulations. Licensee represents and warrants that it or its employees, consultants, or customers who gain access to the Software, Data, or Documentation are not a national, resident, located in or under the control of, or acting on behalf of any person, entity, or country subject to such U.S. export controls.

10.3 **Commercial Terms and Conditions for U.S. Government Use**—This License Agreement contains ESRI's commercial terms and conditions. Licensee's rights in the Software, Data, and Documentation are strictly limited to the uses granted by this License Agreement pursuant to FAR 12.211, FAR 12.212, and DFARS 227.7202. In the event any court, arbitrator, or board holds that the U.S. Government has greater rights to any portion of the Software, Data, or Documentation, such rights shall extend only to the portion(s) affected and use, duplication, or disclosure by the U.S. Government is subject to restrictions as provided in FAR 52.227-19 (June 1987), FAR 52.227-14 (ALT III) (June 1987), DFARS 252.227-7015 (NOV 1995), or NFS 1852.227-86 (December 1987), as applicable. No other license terms or conditions shall apply unless

expressly agreed in writing by ESRI and Licensee. ESRI Software is unpublished and all rights reserved under copyright laws of the United States.

10.4 Taxes and Fees, Shipping Charges—License fees quoted to Licensee are exclusive of any and all taxes or fees including, but not limited to, sales tax, use tax, value-added tax (VAT), customs, duties, or tariffs, and shipping and handling charges.

10.5 No Implied Waivers—The failure of either party to enforce any provision of this License Agreement shall not be deemed a waiver of the provisions or of the right of such party thereafter to enforce that or any other provision.

10.6 Severability—The parties mutually agree that if any provision of this License Agreement is held to be unenforceable for any reason, such provision shall be reformed only to the extent necessary to make the intent of the language enforceable.

10.7 Counterparts—This License Agreement may be executed in counterparts, all of which, taken together, shall be deemed one (1) original document.

10.8 Successor and Assigns—Licensee shall not assign, sublicense, or transfer Licensee's rights or delegate its obligations under this License Agreement without ESRI's prior written consent, and any attempt to do so without consent shall be void. This License Agreement shall be binding upon the respective successors and assigns of the parties to this License Agreement. Notwithstanding, a U.S. Government contractor may assign its rights under this License Agreement to a U.S. Government Agency upon written notice to ESRI if the U.S. Government Agency assents to the terms of this License Agreement.

10.9 Survival of Terms—The provisions of Articles 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 of this License Agreement shall survive the expiration or termination of this License Agreement for any reason.

10.10 Equitable Relief—Licensee agrees that any breach of this License Agreement by Licensee may cause irreparable damage and that, in the event of such breach, in addition to any and all remedies at law, ESRI shall have the right to seek an injunction, specific performance, or other equitable relief in any court of competent jurisdiction to prevent violation of these terms and without the requirement of posting a bond or undertaking or proving injury as a condition for relief.

10.11 Governing Law, Arbitration

- A. *Licensees in the United States of America, Its Territories, and Outlying Areas*—This License Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California without reference to conflict of laws principles. Except as provided in Article 10.10 above, any dispute arising out of or relating to this License Agreement, or the breach thereof, which cannot be settled through negotiation, shall be finally settled by arbitration administered by the American Arbitration Association under its Commercial Arbitration Rules, and judgment on the award rendered by the arbitrator may be entered in any court having jurisdiction thereof. If Licensee is a U.S. Government agency, this License Agreement is subject to the Contract Disputes Act of 1978, as amended (41 U.S.C. 601–613), in lieu of the Arbitration provisions of this clause.
- B. *All Other Licensees*—Except as provided in Article 10.10 above, all disputes arising in connection with this License Agreement that cannot be settled through negotiation shall be finally settled under the Rules of Arbitration of the International Chamber of Commerce by one (1) arbitrator appointed in accordance with said Rules. The language of the arbitration shall be in English. The place of the arbitration shall be at a mutually agreed location. This License Agreement shall not be governed by the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods, the application of which is expressly excluded. Either party shall, at the request of the other, make available documents or witnesses relevant to the major aspects of the dispute.

2. "Concurrent use license" means a license that permits execution of the Software on any computer on the network. The number of simultaneous/concurrent users may be controlled by a License Manager to access and use the Software, Data, or Documentation.

3. "Server license" means a license for (server-side) Software that (i) resides on a server computer and provides services to multiple users and/or client computers in a distributed computing environment, or (ii) resides on an individual desktop computer and provides services to that computer in conjunction with ArcGIS Desktop or other Server Software. For example, an ArcSDE direct connection with an ArcGIS Desktop application, or an ArcSDE direct connection with ArcIMS or ArcGIS Server is a server license.
4. A "Stand-alone Deployment license" grants the right to Licensee to redistribute a stand-alone application to end users, provided the application is installed on each computer on which the application is run. The Stand-alone Deployment license requires payment of redistribution or deployment fees, except for MapObjects LT.
5. A "Server Deployment license" grants the right to Licensee to redistribute an application via a network, the Internet, or Intranet to end users of the application (also known as an "Internet Redistribution license"). The Server Deployment license does not require payment of additional deployment or redistribution fees, except for MapObjects—Java Edition.
6. Extensions to Software programs follow the same scope of use as that granted for the corresponding Software programs. For example, if Licensee orders Concurrent Use ArcInfo, then any associated extension is also licensed for concurrent use or if Licensee orders an ArcGIS Server extension, that extension is also licensed for use on a server.
7. The ArcGIS Server, ArcIMS, ArcSDE, MapObjects—Java Edition, and Tracking Server (collectively "Server Software") licenses are licensed per Server/CPU. Each Server Software license may be installed on up to 2 CPUs in one server; licenses for additional CPUs are available. Server licenses include the rights to develop, test, and deploy applications to end users via a network, the Internet, or Intranet on or from the same licensed server, provided the source and object code are not accessible to users of the application and that Licensee does not generate revenue directly by charging for access to the site or service by selling data, pay-per-view, subscription fee, or similar means by utilization of the Software. Licensee shall not use any type of development or testing licenses, including those licenses installed in a staging server environment (Staging Server licenses) to deploy applications for production use by end users. The administration tools for ArcIMS, ArcSDE, and MapObjects—Java Edition may be copied and redistributed throughout Licensee's organization. User developed ArcGIS Server administration tools may be copied throughout Licensee's organization, but the ArcCatalog application (found in the ArcGIS Desktop (ArcView, ArcEditor, or ArcInfo) may not be copied unless part of a licensed ArcGIS Desktop installation. The ArcIMS license includes the right to deploy MapObjects—Windows Edition applications on the Internet or Intranet. Licensee shall not develop client/server solutions with the ArcIMS Java Archive (JAR) files without a license for the MapObjects—Java Edition Developer Kit.
8. ESRI and its licensor(s) grant Licensee a nonexclusive, nontransferable, limited license to use, copy, and prepare derivative works by
 - (a) Translating "alroute.mld" (hereinafter "Dictionary") from the original text in the English language;
 - (b) Editing Geographic Data Technology (GDT) Data included within ArcLogistics Route; and
 - (c) Adding Data (owned by Licensee or others) to ArcLogistics Route Software.

The license grant is conditioned as follows:

- (a) The derivative works are for Licensee's internal use only;
- (b) ESRI and its licensor(s) retain all exclusive right, title, and interest in and benefits from the derivative works, except Data owned by Licensee or others; and
- (c) Licensee expressly waives and relinquishes any and all ownership including, but not limited to, copyright, moral rights, or any other statutory or common law claims to the derivative works, except for Data owned by Licensee or others.

Licensee shall not translate, modify, or edit in any way the software name "ArcLogistics Route," software logo, any third party software, any text other than the Dictionary, or any Data other than GDT's.

The amount of Data used by Licensee is limited by Data credits purchased. Additional license fees are required if ArcLogistics Route with Data is to be accessed by more than one (1) ArcLogistics Route license.

9. ArcPad SOFTWARE IS NOT LICENSED FOR NAVIGATIONAL USE.
10. This is a "Dual Use License," meaning the Software may be installed on a desktop computer and may be used simultaneously with either a Personal Digital Assistant (PDA) or handheld mobile computer provided that the Software is only used by a single individual at any one (1) time.
11. Licensee shall not redistribute or disclose the MapObjects developer license file (*.lic). Developers must attribute as follows: "Portions of this computer program are owned by LizardTech, Inc., and are Copyright © 1995–2002 LizardTech, Inc., and/or the University of California. All rights reserved. U.S. Patent No. 5,710,835."
12. Redistribution rights for standard or Internet application(s) may be subject to payment of additional license fees. Other restrictions notwithstanding, Licensee may redistribute commercial applications to its sublicensee(s) provided Licensee

uses a written sublicense agreement that protects ESRI's rights in its Software, Data, and Documentation to the same extent as the ESRI License Agreement, and that includes the following terms, as a minimum:

- (a) Sublicensee may not reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the ESRI Software, Data, or Documentation, except to the extent permitted by applicable law, copy for commercial use, transfer, or assign its rights under the license grant; and
 - (b) Sublicensee may not use any ESRI Software, Data, or Documentation, in whole or in part, separate from Licensee's executable application.
 - (c) Third party dependent or required components are redistributable subject to permission from the owner or author.
13. Subject to an annual renewal fee.
14. Licensee may use Business Objects Crystal Reports software only with the ESRI Software with which it was acquired and subject to the Crystal Reports Professional License Agreement available on the media. However, for use of Crystal Reports software with Concurrent Use ArcGIS Software licenses, Licensee may install and use a Crystal Reports license on any computer on the network on which the ArcGIS Desktop Concurrent Use Software is used, but it may only be used with the ESRI Software with which it was acquired, as previously noted. Licensee may not use a software program or system to cache or queue report requests.
15. The Redistribution Stand-alone (or Deployment) license is per application per computer. For MapObjects—Windows Edition, Internet or Intranet Deployment requires an ArcIMS Internet Deployment License. Except for ArcIMS licenses, one (1) Internet Deployment license is required for each ArcIMS server/CPU that runs Web mapping applications built with MapObjects—Windows Edition. For MapObjects—Java Edition, Internet or Intranet Deployment requires a MapObjects—Java Internet Deployment License. An application upgrade is not a redeployment as long as it uses the same major revision of ArcGIS Schematics SDK, MapObjects—Windows Edition, or MapObjects—Java Edition.
16. The MapObjects—Java Edition contains Java Archive (JAR) files, which indicate they are authentic ESRI-certificated files when used over the Internet. Any Licensee certificate placed on the modified "re-jarred" files cannot reference ESRI as a source of trusted content. In addition to any other rights and restrictions in the Agreement, Licensee may use the MapObjects—Java Edition on a single computer to
- (a) Build applet(s) that are used only as an internal component in end user interfaces, and to copy the applet(s) to additional computers (e.g., Web Server) from which Licensee may deploy the applet(s) to end users via download in the course of browsing or interacting with Licensee's Web pages. End user redistribution of the applet(s) is not allowed; and
 - (b) Build stand-alone Java Applications. Licensee may deploy the Java class ESRI certificated libraries as an integral part of Licensee's application(s); and
 - (c) Build servlets and/or Enterprise JavaBeans with MapObjects—Java components, requiring a MapObjects—Java Internet Deployment License for each server configuration; and
 - (d) Distribute MapObjects Java applets, provided (i) Licensee's Web pages or software application(s) is targeted at end users and not as a development tool; (ii) Licensee does not use ESRI's name, logos, or trademark to market Licensee's Web pages or application(s); and (iii) Licensee includes a valid Licensee copyright notice on Licensee's Web pages and software application(s).
17. ArcSDE is licensed on a Server/CPU basis and on a one-to-one basis with a relational database. Licensee may run ArcSDE on a Server to connect to a DBMS, or may connect directly to a DBMS by running ArcSDE on an individual desktop computer. Each ArcSDE Server license permits multiple ArcSDE instances on one (1) server or one (1) desktop computer if Licensee has multiple database instances on the corresponding database Server. Licensee may not connect to more than one (1) database server with an ArcSDE license. ArcSDE for Coverages is licensed only in conjunction with ArcView, ArcEditor, or ArcInfo concurrent use licenses, or ArcSDE Server or ArcIMS Server licenses. Licensee may reproduce and redistribute ArcSDE for Coverages for its internal use.
18. Licensee may reproduce and redistribute the ArcReader and/or ArcExplorer Software provided all of the following occur:
- (a) The ArcReader or ArcExplorer Software is reproduced and redistributed in its entirety whether as a stand-alone application or as an embedded GIS viewing tool on Licensee's own deliverable;
 - (b) An Agreement accompanies each copy of the ArcReader or ArcExplorer Software that protects the ArcReader or ArcExplorer Software to the same extent as the ESRI License Agreement, and the recipient agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions of the Agreement;
 - (c) All copyright and trademark attributions/notices are reproduced;
 - (d) There is no charge or fee attributable to the use of the ArcReader or ArcExplorer Software; and

19. Data provided with ArcPad StreetMap may be used for mapping, geocoding, and routing purposes but may not be used for dynamic routing purposes. Dynamic routing or "real-time guidance" is predictive routing and is not included in the ArcPad StreetMap functionality. For instance, ArcPad StreetMap may not be used to alert a user about upcoming maneuvers (such as warning of an upcoming turn) or calculating an alternate route if a turn is missed.
20. ESRI Business Information Systems Software, Data, and Documentation shall be subject to the Permitted Uses and Uses Not Permitted described below

"Permitted Uses:

- (a) Licensee is granted permission to include resultant maps, reports, or other data output derived from ESRI Business Information Systems Software, Data, and Documentation only as part of Licensee's value-added products and/or services (e.g., Licensee's client reports, presentation packages, marketing studies, etc.) to current or prospective clients, so long as the resultant maps, reports, or other data output derived from ESRI Business Information Systems Software, Data, and Documentation comprises less than twenty percent (20%) of the total value of the Licensee's client reports, presentation packages, or marketing studies.

Uses Not Permitted:

- (a) Licensee shall not sell; rent; lease; sublicense; lend; assign; time-share; or act as a service bureau or Application Service Provider (ASP) of full, complete, stand-alone reports, maps, or data output created from ESRI Business Information Systems Software, Data, and Documentation without first entering into an appropriate reseller-type agreement with ESRI.
 - (b) Unless Licensee has separately licensed a copy of Community Coder, or ESRI Business Information Systems Data that permits appending of the Community Tapestry market segmentation system codes ("Tapestry Codes"), Licensee shall not use the ESRI Business Information Systems Data to assign or append Tapestry Codes to addresses or geographical data not included with ESRI Business Information Systems Software, Data, and Documentation. If Licensee is granted the right to assign Tapestry Codes to Licensee's own files or records (i.e., profiling), Tapestry Codes shall not be disclosed to or used for the benefit of third parties nor shall Licensee provide any third party with mapping, indexing or delivery services made possible through the use of the deliverables without ESRI Business Information Systems's express written permission.
 - (c) Licensee shall not use, copy, redistribute, publicly display, rebroadcast, or otherwise retransmit the ESRI Business Information Systems Software, Data, and Documentation on the Internet without first entering into an appropriate Internet/Intranet Deployment-type agreement with ESRI.
 - (d) Licensee shall not withhold any substantial right (e.g., extension of credit) from any individual based solely on the Community Tapestry market segmentation systems type of said individual's place of residence.
21. The ArcGIS Engine Developer Kit grants the right to develop an unlimited number of applications on a single computer and to deliver the applications with or without the Engine Runtime Software to end users. The ArcGIS Engine Developer Kit licenses and Engine Runtime licenses may be licensed independent of the other. Licensee shall not redistribute the Engine Developer Kit authorization file. The Engine Runtime licenses shall not be used for development of Engine applications. Internet and Server development and deployment is not permitted. An end user must license either ArcGIS Engine Runtime Software or other ArcGIS Desktop Software (ArcView, ArcEditor, or ArcInfo) to obtain the right to run an unlimited number of applications built from the ArcGIS Engine Developer Kit on one (1) computer. The ArcGIS Engine Runtime Extensions shall not be used in combination with ArcGIS Desktop Software to run ArcGIS Engine applications. Developers must attribute as follows: "Portions of this computer program are owned by LizardTech, Inc., and are Copyright © 1995–2002 LizardTech, Inc., and/or the University of California. All rights reserved. U.S. Patent No. 5,710,835."
 22. Server Software may be used in logical, virtual, and "on-demand" server configurations. When counting the number of CPU licenses required for each type of server configuration, ESRI counts all the physical CPUs in a server where the Server Software is installed and/or running. In logical server configurations each Server Software license may be installed on up to two (2) CPUs in one (1) logical server. For "on-demand computing" dormant CPUs do not need to be licensed until they are activated. In virtual server configurations all CPUs in the server must be licensed.
 23. A multicore computer chip with "N" number of CPUs is treated as "N" CPUs. For example, a server that has a dual-core computer chip on it would need to be licensed for two (2) CPUs, even though there is a single computer chip core that holds the two (2) CPUs.



ESRI MPA TERMS AND CONDITIONS (State and Local)

ARTICLE 1—DEFINITIONS

As used herein, the following words, phrases, or terms in this Master Purchase Agreement ("Agreement") shall have the following meanings:

"Licensee" means the governmental body that has signed this Agreement or an Authorized Entity that places orders pursuant to this Agreement.

"Authorized Entity" means a political subdivision of the governmental body authorized by the contracting governmental body to order and acquire Software, Data, Documentation, products, or services through this Agreement.

"License Agreement" means the General License Terms and Conditions (E200).

ARTICLE 2—TERM OF AGREEMENT

The Licensee's right to purchase under this Agreement shall remain in effect for three (3) years from the effective date unless terminated earlier as prescribed in Article 5—Termination; Cancellation. At the end of the initial and any succeeding term, the parties may negotiate a new term. The term of any Software or Data licenses ordered through this Agreement shall be as stated in the License Agreement. ESRI may update the pricing in this Agreement no more than once in a twelve (12) month period. ESRI may elect to not renew the Agreement should total orders for licenses, training, consulting, or custom application development not exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) per year or one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) per any two (2)-year period.

ARTICLE 3—PRODUCT OFFERINGS

ESRI may, at its sole discretion, discontinue offering any Software, Data, other product, or service included in this Agreement at any time upon reasonable written notice.

ESRI may, at its sole discretion, offer new Software, services, Data, Documentation, hardware, or larger quantity discount pricing by providing written notice. ESRI may require additional license terms prior to use of new Software or Data. Such notice shall become part of this Agreement upon (i) ordering Software, hardware, or services covered by the notice or (ii) thirty (30) days after Licensee's receipt of notice, whichever is sooner. Licensee may object in writing to the notice prior to the occurrence of items i or ii. Any objections or changes to the notice shall require written agreement of both parties.

ARTICLE 4—GRANT OF LICENSE AND SCOPE OF USE

The license grant and permitted uses specified in Article 3 and Article 4 of the License Agreement are restricted to use within the United States of America, its possessions, and territories. For Internet mapping Software, the server must be located within the United States of America, its possessions, and territories.

ARTICLE 5—TERMINATION; CANCELLATION

5.1 Termination

This Agreement may be terminated by either party upon forty-five (45) days' written notice. Should the notice specify termination for cause, the recipient of the notice shall have fifteen (15) days in which to correct or cure any default or defect in performance. On termination of this Agreement, all accounts and payments will be processed according to financial arrangements set forth herein for performance rendered to the date of termination. After termination, Licensee shall no longer be permitted to place orders under this Agreement. ESRI, at its sole election, may terminate the right of any Authorized Entity to participate in this Agreement in accordance with this provision without terminating the Agreement with respect to the governmental body or any other Authorized Entity.

5.2 Cancellation

Purchase orders, other than for the initial purchase, may be canceled by the Licensee in whole or in part, upon forty-five (45) days' written notice to ESRI. There will be no cancellation charge for canceled Software unless the Software has been delivered. If the Software has been shipped, the cancellation will require Licensee payment of return shipping costs. Licensee has the right to cancel hardware purchases forty-five (45) days prior to scheduled delivery without cost. After hardware delivery or within forty-five (45) days of scheduled delivery, cancellation of the hardware purchase is subject to a manufacturer cancellation charge not to exceed thirty-five percent (35%) of hardware list price.

5.3 Deficiency Action

Without prejudice to any other right or remedy available to ESRI, ESRI may terminate this Agreement provided Licensee is given fifteen (15) days prior notice to cure deficiency.

- a. If Licensee fails to pay any license fees to ESRI in accordance with the requirements of this Agreement; or
- b. If Licensee distributes ESRI Software, Data, and Documentation to any person or entity other than a Licensee; or
- c. If Licensee discloses any trade secret technology and other information proprietary to ESRI in breach of this Agreement.

5.4 License Survival

Upon voluntary termination of this Agreement for the convenience of Licensee or expiration of this Agreement, Licensee may continue to retain and use such licensed ESRI Software, Data, and Documentation in accordance with the General License Terms and Conditions; Exhibit 1, Scope of Use; and any other license terms contained herein. Licensee may then directly and separately contract for Software updates, maintenance, and/or technical support service.

ARTICLE 6—NONAPPROPRIATION OF FUNDS; LIMITATION

6.1 Funding

Where the financial obligations of the Licensee payable after the current fiscal year are contingent upon funds for that purpose being appropriated, budgeted, or otherwise made available and the funds are not appropriated or otherwise available, this Agreement may be terminated as set forth in Article 5.

6.2 No Minimum Purchase

Licensee does not guarantee to purchase any certain amount under this Agreement.

ARTICLE 7—ORDERS

7.1 Licensee Purchase Orders

Licensee shall issue purchase orders to ESRI for Software, Data, services, or hardware based on the fees specified in this Agreement. The Licensee is requested to confirm hardware pricing and model availability with ESRI prior to placement of a purchase order. The terms and conditions of this Agreement shall govern all orders issued by Licensee. Any additional or different terms included with an order shall require specific approval by ESRI via a written modification to this Agreement to be binding.

7.2 Purchase Order Requirements

All purchase orders shall reference and be subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

The following information/statements shall also be included in each purchase order.

- a. Name or identification of Licensee, place of delivery, and the end user name and contact information
- b. Purchase order number
- c. Date delivery is requested (minimum thirty [30] days after ESRI receipt of order)
- d. Primary site for maintenance if primary maintenance is *not* ordered
- e. Quantity, description, and unit price
- f. On the face of the purchase order, print the following statement: "Subject to Master Purchase Agreement No. 2004MPA4029."

7.3 Additional Quotes

Licensee may request a quote for any new or unlisted Software/services and issue a purchase order under this Agreement, provided ESRI may require additional license terms for use of the new or unlisted Software.

7.4 Authorized Entity

An Authorized Entity may order or acquire Software, Data, Documentation, hardware, services, updates, maintenance, or support under and subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

7.5 Registration/Keycode Request

To activate Software, subject to a License Manager, Licensee may be required to obtain a keycode through ESRI's Web site at myESRI.com or through ESRI's Customer Service Department.

ARTICLE 8—ESRI AUTHORIZED RESELLER ORDERS

Licensee may purchase ESRI Software from an authorized ESRI reseller under the terms of this Agreement. To implement this approach, the following requirements must be satisfied:

- The quotation for ESRI Software and the selection of the ESRI reseller must comply with all applicable State and local public procurement laws and regulations;
- The ESRI reseller must be a member of the ESRI Business Partner Program in good standing at the time the order is placed with ESRI and be authorized to provide the Software ordered as defined at ESRI Web site <http://gis.esri.com/partners/index.html>. Select "Resellers" to view the authorized resellers and the Software they are authorized to provide; and
- The Licensee purchase order forwarded by the reseller to ESRI must list the information requested in Article 7.2, the ESRI reseller name, and the Software MPA pricing [needed because the reseller must use the MPA pricing under the MPA. If the reseller does not use the MPA pricing, then it can't use the MPA.].

If all conditions of sale under the MPA are met, ESRI will accept the order and the authorized reseller will receive a sales commission. ESRI will deliver the ESRI Software directly to the Licensee, invoice, and receive payment for any such order. If ESRI does not accept the order, the Licensee may enter into a direct transaction with the ESRI reseller, and the order will not be processed under this MPA.

Upon request, the ESRI regional office will provide the Licensee with a list of authorized ESRI resellers in good standing that do business in the State.

ARTICLE 9—PRICING

ESRI will provide Software, Data, Documentation, maintenance, and support specified at the prices incorporated into this Agreement. The specified prices stated in the incorporated ESRI Price List are exclusive of shipping, installation, and tax. The pricing for consulting and training services are subject to annual escalations beginning in January of each year. After the initial term of this Agreement, the prices for Software, Data, Documentation, maintenance, and updates may be escalated annually during any extension to the term of this Agreement.

9.1 Software, Maintenance, and Support

ESRI will provide technical support and maintenance services as specified by the Support Services policies described under "Support" ("Support Services Brochure") on the ESRI Web site home page at www.esri.com.

9.2 Hardware

Hardware purchases will be accomplished in accordance with procedures in Article 11, Hardware Purchases. ESRI is subject to hardware vendors' price fluctuations; however, ESRI shall provide a firm quote for hardware valid for sixty (60) to ninety (90) days upon written request. Licensee shall confirm delivery dates with ESRI's hardware manager prior to placing orders.

9.3 Custom Software and Application Services

ESRI Services are available on a time and materials or firm fixed price basis via a signed task order, but only if this Agreement expressly incorporates the Custom Software, Technical Data, and Assistance License Addendum (E600), including the current Time and Materials Rate Schedule (J-7264-a/BD). The E600 Addendum and the J-7264-a/BD Rate Schedule together comprise the applicable terms, staffing, and hourly labor rates (hourly rates applicable only for time and materials projects) for any such work to be performed under this Agreement. Labor rates are subject to annual escalation not

to exceed seven and one-half percent (7.5%) per year in January of each year. The scope of work and any additional terms are subject to mutual agreement in the task order. Information and arrangements regarding Custom Software and Application Services are available from the Implementation Services Program Manager, Craig Morgan, at 909-793-2853, ext. 1546.

9.4 Training Services

Training will be provided in accordance with the policies defined under "Education and Training" at www.esri.com and the ESRI Client Site Training Terms and Conditions (E207) incorporated herein. Training prices are subject to annual escalation, not-to-exceed seven and one-half percent (7.5%) in January of each year.

ARTICLE 10—TERMS OF COMPENSATION AND ACCEPTANCE

10.1 Terms of Compensation

Software and hardware will be invoiced one-hundred percent (100%) upon shipment.

10.2 Acceptance and Payment

Software and hardware installation and training services, as applicable, will be invoiced upon completion. When ESRI installation is ordered, acceptance occurs upon completion of ESRI Software installation and testing, unless rejected in writing.

Licensee agrees to pay each invoice in full within thirty (30) days of receipt of a valid invoice.

Unless rejected in writing, acceptance of any shipment of ESRI Software, Data, Documentation, and hardware shall be presumed to have occurred fifteen (15) days after shipment by ESRI.

ESRI may reject any purchase order if Licensee fails or refuses to pay any license or service fee due.

ARTICLE 11—HARDWARE PURCHASES

11.1 Hardware Purchase Procedures

ESRI is a value-added hardware reseller. As such, ESRI is restricted from selling hardware to any user who has not licensed ESRI Software. Licensee acknowledges ESRI's representations in this regard.

ESRI shall provide hardware prices by written quotation prior to issue of an order. ESRI will order hardware upon receipt of the Licensee's purchase order.

11.2 ESRI Installation of Workstation and/or Peripheral Equipment

When ordered by Licensee, ESRI will provide a hardware vendor's installation service for applicable hardware ordered under this Agreement in Licensee's designated office within one hundred twenty (120) days (if possible), depending on vendor inventory/delivery schedules. Installation dates may be changed by mutual consent of ESRI and Licensee. This installation shall include the successful interfacing and testing of equipment according to standard procedures associated with each manufactured item of the system.

11.3 Procedures at Site

During the installation period, ESRI shall coordinate with the hardware vendor to guide the Licensee's systems administrator on the installation and administration of the new hardware system as it relates to the operation of ESRI Software and other related Software. As the two parties work together on installation tasks, the systems administrator will be guided through key procedures needed to install and administer ESRI Software and other related software on the equipment.

11.4 Deliverables

- Hardware system as ordered
- Interfaced ESRI Software and hardware, as applicable
- Assistance in familiarization with operation of hardware (ESRI and hardware vendor, as applicable)

11.5 Responsibilities

- Licensee shall designate a person to act as its system administrator. Prior to the start date for installation, Licensee shall, at its own expense, prepare the designated site in accordance with the hardware manufacturer or third party vendor's ("Vendor's") specifications. These preparations shall include installation of appropriate electrical wiring, air conditioning, heating, humidity control, lighting, and space for hardware components.

- ESRI shall coordinate the shipping, insurance, and delivery of the various hardware components including communication with Licensee regarding appropriate logistics.
- Licensee shall provide appropriate insurance coverage for the equipment after delivery.

11.6 Manufacturer's Warranty and Infringement Indemnity

ESRI will pass through any hardware warranty and infringement indemnity from each respective manufacturer directly to the Licensee. Neither ESRI Software and Data nor vendor's hardware is designed for use in fail-safe environments or mission-critical applications such as, but not limited to, running nuclear operations, airport/aircraft control systems, or 911 emergency and life support response systems. Licensee shall hold ESRI and the hardware vendor harmless from any claims for loss, cost, damage, expense, or liability arising out of, or in connection with, the use and performance of Software, Data, hardware, or services in such fail-safe environments or mission-critical applications.

SUCH WARRANTIES AND INDEMNITIES ARE IN LIEU OF AND THIS AGREEMENT EXCLUDES ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, ORAL OR WRITTEN, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, (i) ANY WARRANTY THAT THE HARDWARE IS FAULT-FREE, WILL OPERATE WITHOUT INTERRUPTION, OR IS COMPATIBLE WITH ALL EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE CONFIGURATIONS; AND (ii) ANY AND ALL WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, NONINTERFERENCE, SYSTEM INTEGRATION, AND NONINFRINGEMENT.

ARTICLE 12—GENERAL PROVISIONS

12.1 Notice

Notice required or contemplated by either party must be delivered in person or by courier, express mail, facsimile, or postage-prepaid certified or registered airmail addressed to the party for whom it is intended at the address specified herein. Either party may change its address by giving prompt notice to the other party of the change.

12.2 Shipping and Handling

- Standard shipping is by two (2)-day air via UPS or equivalent carrier.
- Expedited express delivery for Software can be arranged.
- It is suggested the shipping and handling charges be confirmed in advance as the ESRI invoicing program will incorporate the current fees automatically. Also, there may be periodic changes due to fluctuations in the transportation industry fees.

12.3 Maintenance

Generally, maintenance is offered on an annual basis. Upon expiration of the initial complimentary maintenance year, or any subsequent maintenance term, Licensee may issue a purchase order under this Agreement for renewal of maintenance at the terms and pricing then in effect. Upon acceptance of an ESRI quotation, the purchase order shall be issued in advance or not later than concurrent with the present maintenance term. Should there be a lapse in maintenance coverage, and at some later date the Licensee chooses to reinstate maintenance, Licensee shall pay maintenance fees for the lapsed period, not to exceed a maximum of two (2) prior years, plus one (1) year's maintenance fees in advance.



LIMITED TERM LICENSE ADDENDUM TO THE MASTER LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR THE ESRI DEVELOPER NETWORK (Domestic)

This Addendum to the License Agreement, ESRI Developer Network ("EDN") Terms and conditions ("Addendum") modifies the License Agreement to incorporate additional or different terms and conditions specifically for the EDN subscription license.

Modification to Master License Agreement

The License Agreement is modified as follows:

1. **Article 1—Definitions**, is amended by the addition of the following definitions:

"EDN Software Library" shall mean the Software, Data, Documentation, License Manager, ArcWeb Services, instructional materials, and any other materials made available to Licensee during the subscription period.

"EDN Website" shall mean the ESRI Web site devoted to the global community of GIS developers through which licensees may download and upload software, data, and information through peer-to-peer sharing.

"Service Pack" shall mean a Software update available to Licensee through the ESRI Support Web page as a download via the Internet or by other means.

2. **Article 4—Scope of Use**, is amended by the addition of the following **Permitted Uses**:

- Licensee may use only the type and number of copies of the Software, Data, Documentation, and ArcWeb Services included in the EDN Software Library during the subscription period for which the appropriate subscription fees have been paid to ESRI in accordance with the licensed configuration on file with ESRI Customer Service for Licensee's internal use and the terms of this Agreement.
- The Licensee may use each EDN subscription license for one (1) developer who may use the EDN Software Library and other resources of the program solely for the purposes of research, development, test, and demonstration of a prototype application to Licensee's customers and internal users for acceptance testing. There are no deployment, runtime, commercial use, or production rights granted by the EDN subscription license.
- Licensee agrees that it will order a separate EDN subscription for each individual developer who accesses the EDN Software Library and EDN Website. Licensee shall also order a separate EDN subscription for each individual developer of a consultant or contractor who requires access to the EDN Library in support of Licensee.
- Licensee may permit each authorized developer to copy and install the EDN Software Library on multiple computers for use solely by the authorized developer(s) covered by an EDN subscription provided Licensee requires the developer(s) to use the software only as permitted by this EDN subscription license.
- Licensee may use, copy, reproduce, and redistribute the Service Pack(s) as part of Licensee's application. Any other right to use, copy, reproduce, and redistribute Software, Data, and Documentation or ArcWeb Services, including updates, is subject to the grants and scope of use in the applicable ESRI license agreement for full commercial use, and use of the EDN Software Library is limited to the permitted uses in this Addendum.
- Licensee may use the EDN Software Library at one (1) location for each subscription.
- Licensee may grant access to server applications developed using the EDN Software Library to Licensee's customers and internal users for acceptance testing purposes only provided that Licensee's customers and internal users will not perform any debugging, configuration, or maintenance.

3. **Article 4—Scope of Use**, is amended by the addition of the following **Uses Not Permitted**:

- A single EDN subscription may not be shared by multiple developers or other users who do not have an EDN subscription.
 - The EDN subscription may not be used for production purposes, and does not include the right to any deployments, runtimes, or server technology for production or other commercial purposes.
 - Licensee shall not transfer or redistribute the EDN Software Library, in whole or in part, among other Licensee sites, or among other individual developers at a single site, except for other developer(s) with an EDN subscription at the site.
 - Licensee shall not publicly disclose results of benchmark testing except with prior written permission of ESRI.
4. **Article 5—Maintenance**, does not apply to the EDN subscription and Licensee shall not be entitled to standard Maintenance. Licensee shall receive updates to the EDN Software Library during the term of the subscription, but ESRI technical support is not available unless Licensee elects to order Developer Support Group technical support services (DSG Support) for the EDN Software Library products eligible for such support.
 5. **Article 6—Term and Termination**, does not apply to the EDN subscription and is replaced by the Term, Termination, and Renewal provision in the General Provisions for the EDN subscription indicated below.
 6. **Article 7—Limited Warranties and Disclaimers**, Section 7.1, Limited Warranties, does not apply to any sample code made available to Licensee through the EDN subscription. Section 7.3, General Disclaimer, shall apply to any sample code. **THE SAMPLE CODE IS PROVIDED "AS IS" WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, EXPRESS OF IMPLIED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, NONINTERFERENCE, SYSTEM INTEGRATION, AND NONINFRINGEMENT. LICENSEE ASSUMES ALL RISK AS TO THE QUALITY AND PERFORMANCE OF THE SAMPLE CODE.**

ArcWeb Services Terms and Conditions for the EDN Subscription

The Master License Agreement is modified by the addition of the following terms for ArcWeb Services included in the EDN subscription:

1. Grant—ESRI hereby grants a nonexclusive, nontransferable, *limited license* to the Licensee, and Licensee hereby accepts the limited license for use of the ArcWeb Service(s), including any applicable data or documentation (hereinafter referred to as "Service(s)"), up to the authorized number of credits during the ESRI Developers Network (EDN) subscription period. Such license includes the right to access the Service(s) made available on the Web site and to use the Service(s) to research, develop, test, and demonstrate prototype Web-based application development as permitted herein. ESRI reserves the right to immediately terminate this license should Licensee use the Service(s) for any use not permitted under this Agreement. Further, ESRI reserves the right to change the number of credits, specific ArcWeb Service(s), and related terms and conditions.

2. Reservation of Ownership and Grant of License—The Service(s) accessed pursuant to this Agreement or any other materials delivered hereunder, is proprietary to ESRI or its licensors and contains trade secrets, inclusive of unpublished specifications. All rights, title, ownership in patents, trademarks, copyrights, trade secrets, know-how, and any proprietary rights in the Service(s) remain exclusively with ESRI or its licensors. The Service(s) is protected by United States copyright laws and applicable international treaties and/or conventions. Licensee acknowledges that the Service(s) is proprietary to ESRI or its licensors.

3. Scope of Use

Licensee may

- a. Use the Service(s) within an internal network environment for Licensee's own internal use as described herein;
- b. Access and use any secure ESRI Web site resources made available to Licensee for Licensee's internal use only, provided that Licensee follows ESRI's terms of use policy specified therein. All password or controlled access information provided by ESRI shall be treated as ESRI confidential information;
- c. The Licensee may use each EDN subscription license for one (1) developer who may use the Service(s), and other resources of the program solely for the purposes of research, development, test, and demonstration of a prototype application to Licensee's customers and internal users. There are no deployment, runtime, commercial, server use,

or production rights granted by the EDN subscription license for Web-enabled applications developed using the ArcWeb Service(s);

- d. Download and store geocoded results only when using the Service known as Address Manager; or
- e. Grant access to server applications developed using the EDN Software Library to Licensee's customers and internal users for acceptance testing purposes only provided that Licensee's customers and internal users will not perform any debugging, configuration, or maintenance.

Licensee may not

- a. Copy, download, store (except as permitted above), publish, transmit, transfer, sell, or otherwise use the Service(s) except as expressly permitted herein;
- b. Sell, lease, lend, rent, timeshare, assign, sublicense, or transfer any right to use the Service(s) to any third party without the prior express written permission of ESRI;
- c. Attempt to unlock or bypass the access code used or uncover any ESRI source code, reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the Service(s) for any purpose, except to the extent permitted by applicable law notwithstanding this restriction, in order to protect ESRI or its supplier(s) trade secrets and proprietary information contained in the Services;
- d. Publicly disclose results of benchmark testing except with prior written permission of ESRI;
- e. Create derivative Service(s) or add value to the Service(s) and thereafter resell or otherwise distribute the Service(s) as Licensee's own services;
- f. Reformat and display the Service(s) in an attempt to mirror or make commercial use of the ESRI Web site;
- g. Use the Service(s) for production or other commercial purposes; or
- h. Use the Service(s) beyond the EDN Subscription period or carry over any credits remaining into a new EDN Subscription period.

4. Third Party Data Sets—If the Service(s) to be used includes third party data sets owned and licensed by Geographic Data Technology, Inc. ("GDT"), TeleAtlas North America, Inc. ("TANA"), Meteorlogix, LLC ("Meteorlogix"), NAVTEQ (Navteq), MDS Data (MDS), or ESRI Italia S.p.A. (ESRI Italia), the applicable license limitations set forth in Attachment No. 1, ArcWeb Service(s) Terms and Condition for the EDN Subscription, Third Party Data Sets—License Limitation, are incorporated by reference and shall apply to this license Agreement. ESRI reserves the right to modify or supplement the terms and conditions in Attachment 1 at any time as ESRI, in its sole discretion, deems necessary to comply with the third party data vendor's requirements.

5. ArcWeb Service(s) Warranty—THE SERVICE(S) IS PROVIDED "AS IS" WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. LICENSEE BEARS ALL RISK AS TO THE QUALITY AND PERFORMANCE OF THE SERVICE(S).

6. Limitation of Liability—IN NO EVENT WILL ESRI BE LIABLE TO LICENSEE FOR DIRECT, INDIRECT, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES RELATED TO THE USE BY THE LICENSEE OF THE SERVICE(S), OR ANY OTHER MATERIALS DELIVERED HEREUNDER EVEN IF ESRI HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGE.

ESRI reserves the right to make any changes it deems necessary or desirable to the Service(s).

General Provisions for the EDN Subscription

The following clauses are added to the Master License Agreement and are specifically applicable to the EDN Software Library and the EDN Subscription

1. Term, Termination, and Renewal—The EDN subscription period and term of the license for use of the EDN Software Library is one (1) year from date of shipment or transmittal of the EDN subscription code. This license expires upon expiration of the EDN Subscription, use of all permitted credits with respect to ArcWeb Services, or earlier by either party upon written notice to the other. Licensee may renew the subscription by payment of the EDN subscription fee on or before the expiration date, so long as Licensee complies with the terms of this Agreement. The license for the EDN subscription and EDN Software Library may terminate if (i) Licensee elects in writing to discontinue use of the EDN Software Library and terminates its EDN Subscription or (ii) either party terminates the EDN subscription or this Agreement for a material breach that is not cured within ten (10) days of written notice to the other party, except that termination is immediate for a material

breach of a nature that it is impossible to cure. No refund of the EDN subscription fee will be made for termination for the EDN subscription, except as required by a judgment of default against ESRI filed in a court of competent jurisdiction.

2. Deinstallation upon Expiration or Termination—ESRI may terminate this Agreement as provided in the General Provisions of the EDN Subscription, Article 1, Term, Termination, and Renewal, above. Upon expiration or termination of the EDN subscription, Licensee shall uninstall, remove, and destroy the EDN Software Library and all components and all whole or partial copies, modifications, or merged portions in any form, and upon ESRI's request, certify to or provide evidence of such deinstallation or destruction to ESRI.

3. Audit Rights—Licensee shall maintain at Licensee's principal place of business complete and accurate business records of the use of the EDN Software Library acquired pursuant to this Agreement. ESRI shall have the right to annually inspect such records at its expense and upon reasonable notice to Licensee and provided such inspection is reasonable in scope and is non-disruptive of Licensee's operations. If an audit reveals that Licensee has used the EDN Software Library for purposes other than those permitted by the EDN subscription license terms set forth in this Agreement, then Subscriber shall pay ESRI's reasonable costs of conducting the audit, in addition to the payment of additional fees based on full use commercial license fees.

4. ARTICLE 1—DEFINITIONS

All words, phrases, or terms defined in other parts of this Agreement shall have the same meaning in this Addendum. The following additional words, phrases, or terms shall have the following meaning:

- i. "Task Order" means a task order issued under this Addendum. (A sample task order form is attached as Attachment A.)
- ii. "Custom Software" means all or any portion of the computer software code, components, dynamic link libraries (DLLs), and programs delivered on any media provided in source, object, or executable code format(s), inclusive of backups, updates, or merged copies permitted hereunder or subsequently supplied under any Task Order, exclusive of Software.
- iii. "Technical Data" means, without limitation, all technical materials including formula, compilations, programs, methods, techniques, know-how, technical assistance, processes, designs, schematics, user documentation, training documentation, specifications, drawings, flowcharts, briefings, test or quality control procedures, or other similar information supplied or disclosed by ESRI under any Task Order.
- iv. "Map Data" means any digital data set(s) including geographic, vector data coordinates, raster, or associated tabular attributes supplied or used in performance of any Task Order.
- v. "Deliverables" means Custom Software, Technical Data, or Map Data specified for delivery or use by Licensee under a Task Order.
- vi. "Supported Software" means the Software identified pursuant to Article 2.

ARTICLE 2—TASK ORDERS AND PROJECT SCHEDULE

ESRI shall provide Deliverables as specified in Task Orders for support of the Software identified therein ("Supported Software").

Unless otherwise provided by ESRI in writing, ESRI's Senior Contract Administrator, _____, is authorized to agree to Task Orders. Licensee shall provide advanced written notification of the name and title of the representative authorized to sign Task Orders and bind Licensee. Each party may enter into Task Orders at its sole discretion and shall not have any obligation under a Task Order until it is signed by both parties.

Each party shall identify in writing the project manager who is responsible for the Deliverables specified in Task Orders. By written notice, either party may replace the project manager at any time with a similarly qualified person.

ESRI shall complete each Task Order in accordance with the schedule specified in that Task Order.

ARTICLE 3—RESERVED

ARTICLE 4—PATENTS AND INVENTIONS

A. Ownership:

ESRI and Licensee agree that the Deliverables produced by ESRI under this Agreement are a "work made for hire" and related copyrights, trademarks, patents, inventions, trade secrets, confidential information are the property of Licensee. Licensee hereby grants ESRI a perpetual, worldwide, royalty-free license to the Generic Code, as defined below, to use, modify, reproduce, copy, and distribute, including the right to create derivative works.

Generic Code means software modules which include functionality which has general applicability to ESRI's user community, including software modules which incorporate Pre-existing Work, as defined below, or existing public or private domain programs, which aid ESRI in performing work under this Agreement. Generic Code does not include software modules that incorporate or use Licensee's confidential information.

B. Pre-Existing Work:

It is understood and agreed that ESRI may use its pre-existing proprietary intellectual property (the "Pre-Existing Work") in performing services or providing deliverables under this Agreement. If ESRI uses any such Pre-Existing Work and so notifies Licensee in writing prior to such delivery or performance, Licensee shall not acquire any proprietary rights to the Pre-Existing Work.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, and in consideration for the fees paid hereunder, ESRI hereby grants to Licensee a nonexclusive, worldwide license in the Pre-Existing Work to use, modify, reproduce and copy the Pre-Existing Work in connection with Licensee's internal business use of the Deliverables.

C. Programming and Design Techniques:

ESRI reserves the right to use, for any purpose, any programming methods, skills or techniques acquired or used by ESRI or its subcontractors in the performance of work associated with this Agreement. There shall be no restraint to ESRI, its employees, agents, or subcontractors in the use of the programming methods, techniques, skills of computer programming and design that may be acquired in the course of performance under this Agreement.

ARTICLE 5—OWNERSHIP, CONFIDENTIALITY, AND EXPORT CONTROLS

Except as specifically granted in this Addendum, ESRI or its licensors own and retain all right, title, and interest in the Deliverables. This Agreement does not transfer ownership rights of any description in the Deliverables to Licensee or any third party.

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, the Deliverables are ESRI confidential and Licensee shall preserve and protect their confidentiality. Insofar as its rights may be legally restricted, Licensee agrees not to reverse engineer or decompile Deliverables delivered only in object code, executable code, or formats subject to similar or greater means of access control (collectively, "Secure Formats"). For Deliverables delivered in source code or other human-readable formats, Licensee shall have met its obligations under this Article if its disclosure of Deliverables is limited to Deliverables in Secure Formats, *provided that* the means for reverse engineering, decompiling, or disassembling such Deliverables is withheld from such disclosure, and the person or entity in receipt of such Deliverables similarly agrees not to perform such acts or allow others to do so.

Except as provided in the preceding paragraph, Licensee shall not disclose the Deliverables to employees or third parties without the advanced written consent of ESRI. However, Licensee may, without such consent, make such disclosures to employees as are reasonably required for the Licensee's authorized use of the Supported Software, provided that such disclosure is strictly limited to the portions of the Deliverables needed for that purpose.

The disclosures permitted under the preceding paragraph shall not relieve Licensee of its obligation to maintain the Deliverables in confidence and comply with all applicable laws and regulations of the United States, including, without limitation, its export control laws. Furthermore, before disclosing all or any portion of the Deliverables to employees or third parties as permitted in the preceding paragraph, Licensee shall inform such employees or third parties of the obligations in this Article and obtain their agreement to be bound by them.

Licensee shall not have any obligation to protect any part of a Deliverable that it can prove: (i) was in Licensee's possession before receipt from ESRI; (ii) is or becomes a matter of public knowledge through no fault of Licensee; (iii) is rightfully disclosed by a third party without a duty of confidentiality; (iv) is disclosed by ESRI to a third party without a duty of confidentiality; (v) is independently developed by Licensee; or (vi) is required to be disclosed by operation of law.

ARTICLE 6—ACCEPTANCE

A. For Time and Materials Task Orders

Deliverables are provided strictly on a time and materials basis. Therefore, Licensee shall accept Deliverables as promptly as practicable after delivery, and Deliverables shall be deemed accepted thirty (30) days after delivery.

B. For Firm Fixed Price Task Orders

Deliverables for fixed price Task Orders shall be categorized as follows:

- i. "DELIVERABLE ACCEPTED" means a Deliverable conforming to applicable Task Order(s) with no more than minor nonconformities. Licensee shall complete its acceptance review within ten (10) working days of receiving each Deliverable.
- ii. "DELIVERABLE ACCEPTED WITH REWORK" means a deliverable substantially conforming to applicable Task Order(s), but having a significant number of identified nonconformities and accepted subject to rework by ESRI. ESRI shall rework the Deliverable for the identified nonconformities and resubmit it within thirty (30) days. Licensee will rerun its acceptance review for the nonconformities detected in the initial review within ten (10) working days of such resubmission and will reclassify the deliverable as either DELIVERABLE ACCEPTED or DELIVERABLE REJECTED.
- iii. "DELIVERABLE REJECTED" means a Deliverable that fails to substantially conform to applicable Task Order(s). ESRI shall rework the Deliverable and resubmit it to Licensee within thirty (30) days, at which time Licensee shall have ten (10) working days to rerun its acceptance review and reclassify the deliverable as either DELIVERABLE ACCEPTED or DELIVERABLE REJECTED.

Licensee agrees it shall not use any Deliverable in its business operations before acceptance as described in Subsections B(i) or B(ii). If ESRI does not receive within ten (10) working days after delivery written notice that the Deliverable is "ACCEPTED WITH REWORK" or "REJECTED" in accordance with B(ii) or B(iii), or if Licensee uses the Deliverable in its business operations, the Deliverable shall be deemed, as of the first to occur of either of these events, to have been accepted.

ARTICLE 7—CHANGES TO SCOPE OF WORK

Licensee may, at any time, request changes within the general scope of an open Task Order. If the parties agree to such changes and such changes cause an increase or decrease in the cost or time required to provide a Deliverable under any Task Order (regardless of whether the Deliverable itself is changed), an equitable adjustment in the price or schedule, or both, shall be made, and this Agreement shall be modified accordingly in writing and signed by both parties.

ARTICLE 8—COMPENSATION; INVOICES

A. For Time and Materials Task Orders

ESRI shall prepare and submit to Licensee written monthly invoices showing the compensation due for work performed under Task Orders. The amount invoiced will be equal to the number of hours expended during the previous month multiplied by the rates for labor categories set forth in Attachment B, plus other burdened direct costs. ESRI may, at its sole discretion, stop work in order to avoid exceeding the total value of applicable Task Orders. Any election to exceed such total value shall not affect the rights or obligations of the parties under this Agreement, including any right to compensation for such excess work and to stop work at anytime after such total value is exceeded.

B. For Firm Fixed Price Task Orders

ESRI shall prepare and submit monthly invoices based on the percent complete for each Deliverable as of the end of the preceding month. Upon acceptance of all Deliverables under a Task Order, the full amount of that Task Order is due.

C. Payment

Licensee shall pay each invoice no later than thirty (30) days after receipt thereof.

ARTICLE 9—REQUIRED CORRECTIONS AND LIMITED WARRANTY

A. Correction of Deliverables and Warranty

1. For Time and Materials Task Orders: Not later than thirty (30) days after acceptance of a Deliverable, Licensee may require ESRI to correct or replace, at ESRI's option, Deliverables that at the time of delivery do not conform with the applicable written specifications included in, or delivered by ESRI pursuant to, the corresponding Task Order. Except as provided in the next paragraph of this Subsection A.1, the cost of replacement or correction shall be determined under the Time and Materials section of the Compensation; Invoices article of this Addendum.

Not later than two (2) years after acceptance of a Deliverable, Licensee may require ESRI to correct or replace, without cost to the Licensee, nonconforming Deliverables, if the nonconformances are due to (i) fraud, lack of good faith, or

willful misconduct on the part of an employee at or above the ESRI Professional Services Department Manager level (collectively, "ESRI Manager") or (ii) the conduct of one or more of ESRI's employees selected or retained by ESRI after an ESRI Manager has reasonable grounds to believe that the employee is habitually careless or unqualified.

ESRI shall have no obligation or liability under this Agreement to correct Deliverables that were nonconforming at the time of delivery, except as provided in this Subsection A.1.

2. For Firm Fixed Price Task Orders: ESRI warrants that for a period of thirty (30) days after acceptance of a Deliverable that the Deliverable will conform, in a manner consistent with professional and technical standards in the software industry, with the applicable written specifications that are included in, or delivered by ESRI pursuant to, the corresponding Task Order.

Consulting activities may include strategic planning, review and oversight of requirements definition, application and database design, and system integration consulting. Management activities may include defining program requirements, establishing budgets and schedules, allocating staff and other resources, and managing and overseeing subcontractor activities. Senior Consultant
