

COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT CSBG SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Scholarships now available for post-secondary education at accredited institutions of higher education or vocational training in the State of Illinois for the 2023 fall semester/quarter.

Scholarships range from \$1,000 to \$5,000 for income-eligible residents.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be City of Chicago resident, who meets the income eligibility requirements.
- Must demonstrate academic achievement, career potential and educational motivation.
- Must be a high school graduate (or equivalent) and/or a student of an institution of higher education, who is seeking to attend an accredited institution of higher education located in the State of Illinois, in the fall semester/quarter of 2023.
