Don't Ignore It- Report it!

The Chicago Human Rights Ordinance prohibits discrimination in employment based on:

| Age (over 40) | Military Status |
| Gender Identity | Criminal History |
| National Origin | Credit History |

It is a violation of the law to discriminate in:
